


Get Connected with Android Devices


Connecting to Hanover's wifi networks using Android devices is simple. Follow these steps to gain internet access on campus.

1. In your device's wifi settings, locate the network you need to connect to and click on it to begin getting connected.
 - a. HC Students for all students
 - b. HC Faculty Staff for all employees
2. You will be prompted to enter a username and password which will be your Hanover username and password (**your username is what is before the @ in your email address**).

3. Some Android devices will require you to specify the certificate. Click "Select certificate" and choose "Use system certificates".
