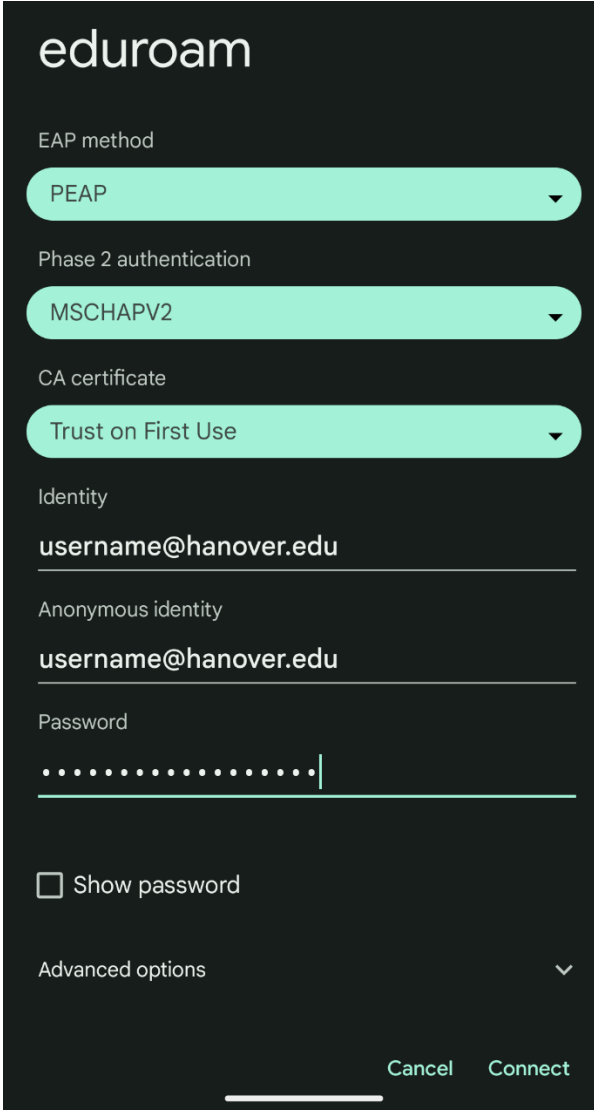


Get Connected with Android Devices

Connecting to Hanover's wireless networks using Android devices is simple. Follow these steps to gain internet access on campus.

1. In your device's WiFi settings, locate the "eduroam" network and click on it to begin getting connected.

EAP Method: PEAP

⚠ if prompted for "domain", enter: campus.hanover.edu ⚠

- When all fields are filled correctly, click “Connect”. You will then be asked to confirm whether you trust the certificate or not. Verify that the certificate server name is “ldap.hanover.edu” and click “Yes, connect”.
