
Get Connected via Apple Phone/Computer


Connecting to the eduroam network is straightforward on Apple phones and computers, but there are some steps you should take note of.

iPhone/iPad

- 1. In your device's wifi settings click on the eduroam network to begin getting connected.
- 2. You should now be prompted to enter a username and password to connect. You will enter your full Hanover email address and password. Leave "Mode" as the default setting of "Automatic". When you have filled in your credentials, click the "Join" button.




3. Now you will see a pop up regarding the certificate. You will notice the "Not Trusted" warning marked in red, however you can see that the certificate is labeled "ldap.hanover.edu" and does not expire until July of 2023. This is our certificate; you may click the "Trust" button in the upper right corner.




If the certificate is labeled anything other than Idap.hanover.edu DO NOT click the "Trust" button. Please contact IT for help setting up your connection at (812)866-6899.

Macbook/iMac

- 1. Open the wifi menu and select the eduroam network.
- 2. You will be prompted to enter a username and password. Use your full Hanover email address and password. Do not change the "No certificate selected" dropdown. Click the "OK" button to proceed. If you check the "Remember this information" box, you will not be prompted to sign in every time you connect to the network.



3. Now a pop up will launch asking you to verify the certificate. You can see in the details that this certificate is initiated from "Idap.hanover.edu". Click the "Show Certificate" button.



4. You should see all the details regarding the certificate. You can see it expires in July of 2023. Click the "Continue" button.



If the certificate is labeled anything other than Idap.hanover.edu DO NOT click the "Continue" button. Please contact IT for help setting up your connection at (812)866-6899.

5. You will be prompted to enter the password to your Mac to certify this action. Click the "Update Settings" button.
