

7. You should now see the homepage for your LinkedIn Learning account. You will see “Top picks for you” based on the topics you showed interest in. You can also search for more specific courses or topics by typing in the search bar.



8. You will notice the “Me” dropdown has a tab entitled “Assigned by Hanover College”. Here, you will find any courses that you are currently required to complete. There is also a “Recommended by Hanover College” tab. This tab will help you find courses that Hanover recommends. The “In Progress” tab will also keep track of any courses you are currently in the process of completing, so you can pick up where you left off last time. The “Learning History” tab will log the courses you have successfully completed.
