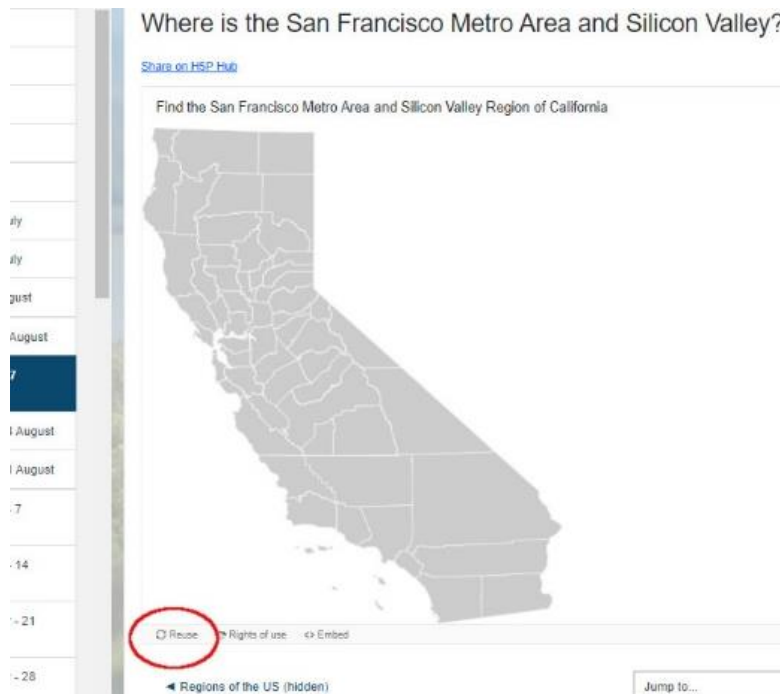


How to save an H5P activity from a page into the course's Content Bank

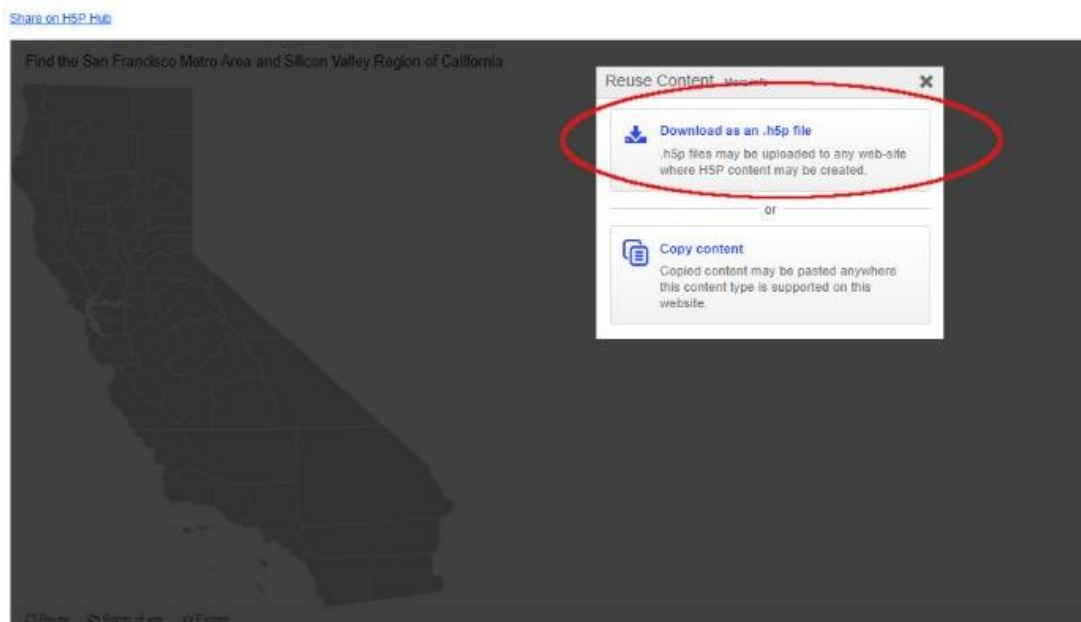
When you create H5P objects within the content bank, they are automatically saved in the content bank for your particular course. If you used the Interactive Content plugin to make your H5P activity or resource, though, there is a way that you can upload it into the content bank for safe keeping.

1. Click on the **Reuse link** below your H5P activity.

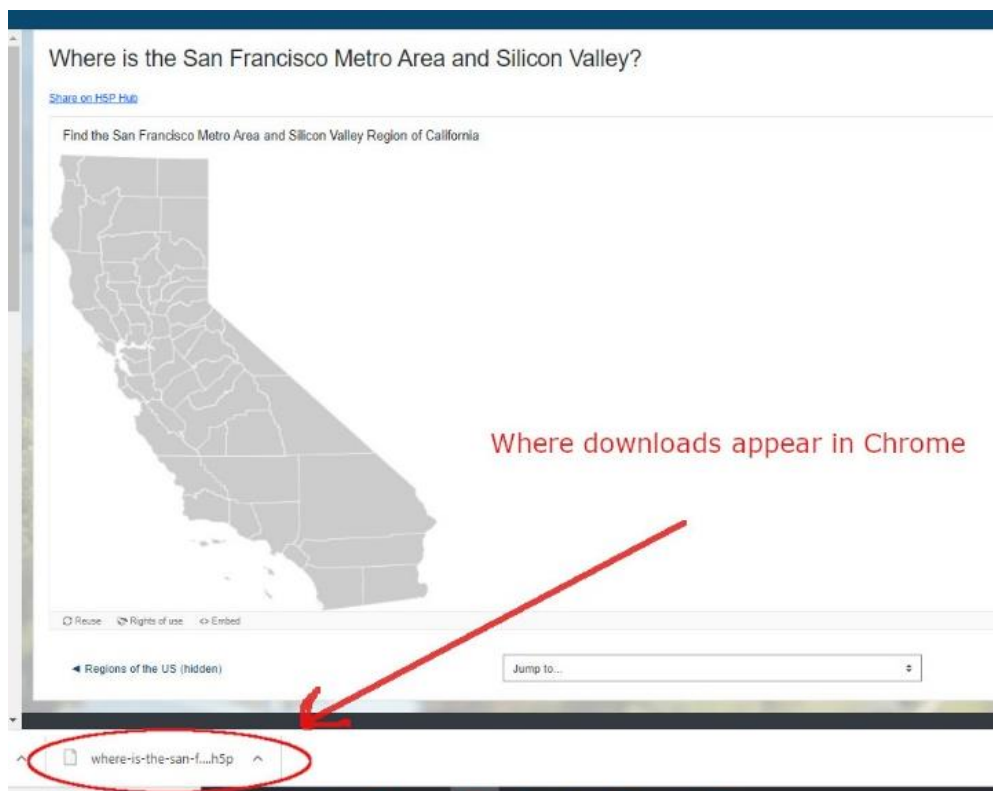


2. Click on the **Download as H5P** link on the top of the dialog box.

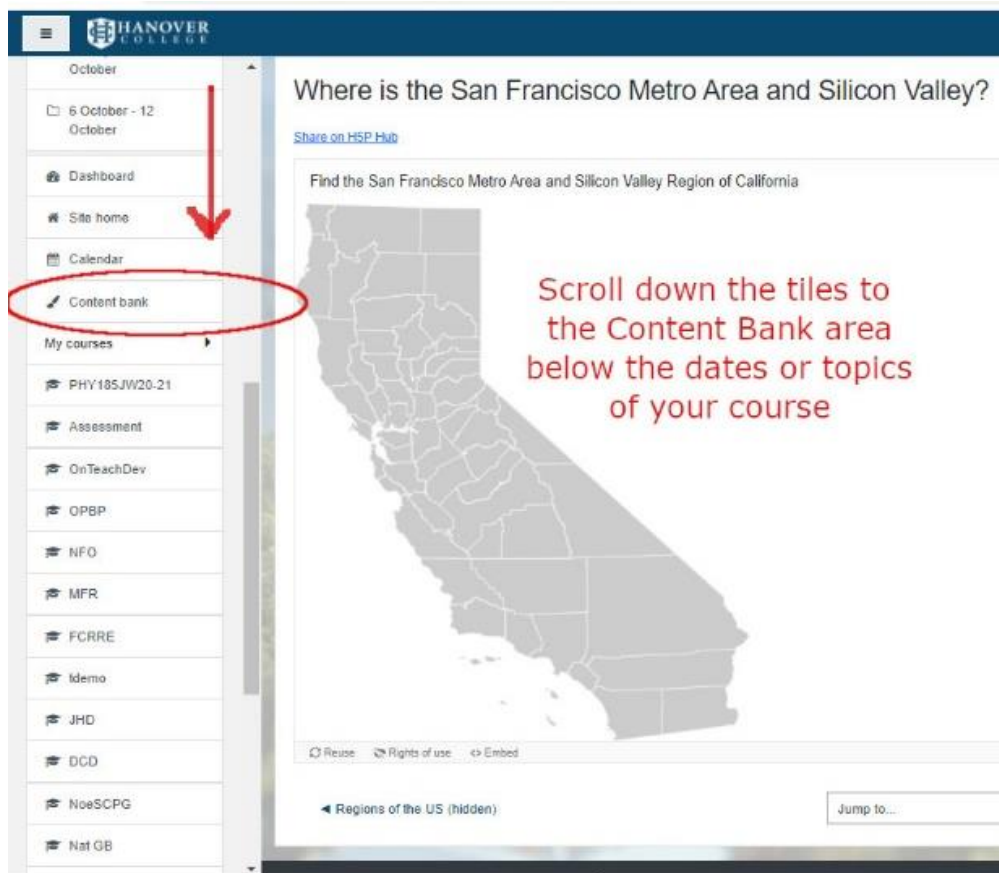
Where is the San Francisco Metro Area and Silicon Valley?



3. Make sure that it downloads. In Chrome, downloads appear in the lower left corner. In Firefox, you'll see a dialog box appear where you can open or save the download. Save the download. .

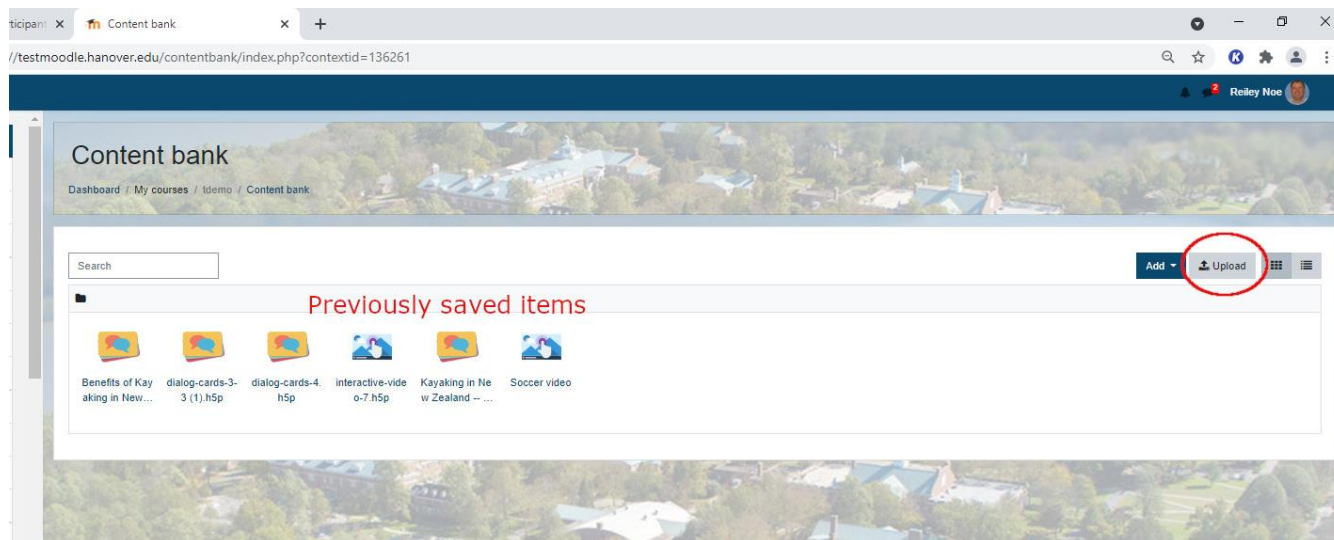


4. Scroll down the tiles to the left side of the screen. Go below your course weeks or topics and click on the **tile for the Content Bank**.

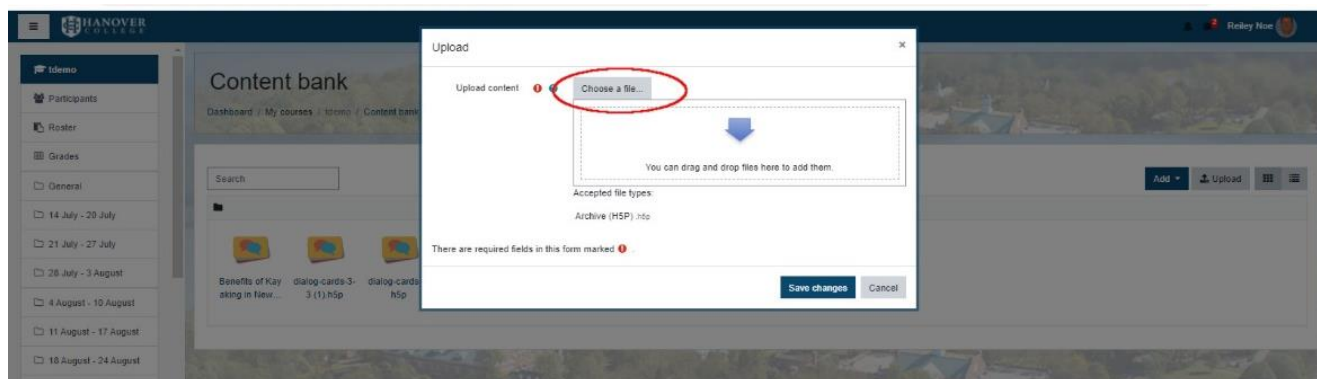


5. The content bank will take several seconds to load. Please be patient. It will look like what you see below, but without saved H5P activities, like the icons you see below. When you save them, though, they will look this way in your content bank.

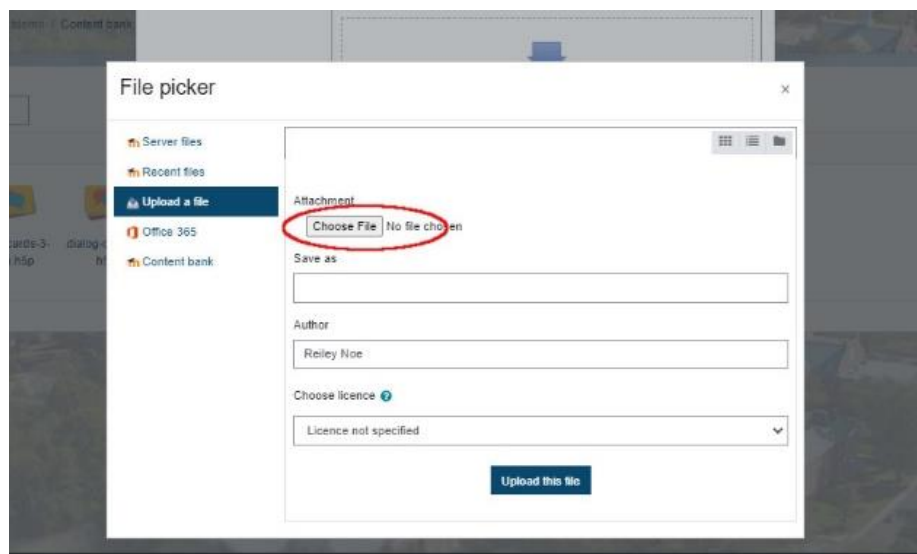
Click the **Upload** button.



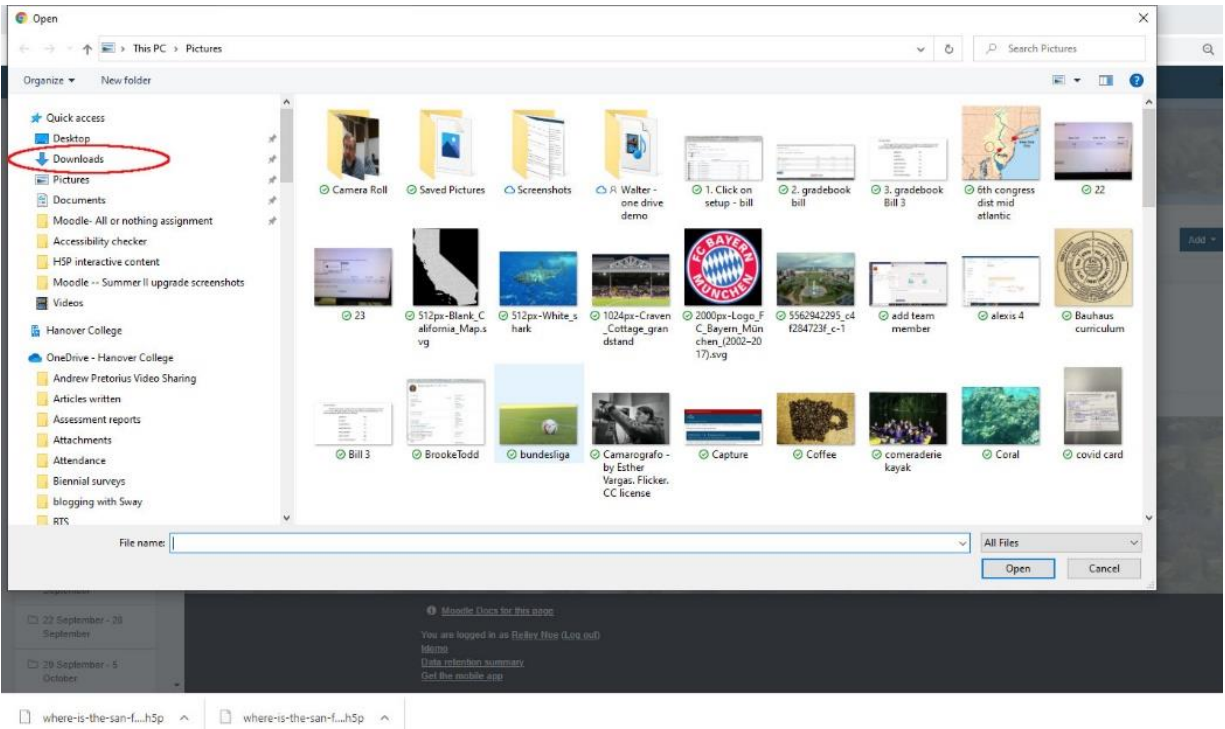
6. Click on the **Choose a File** button.



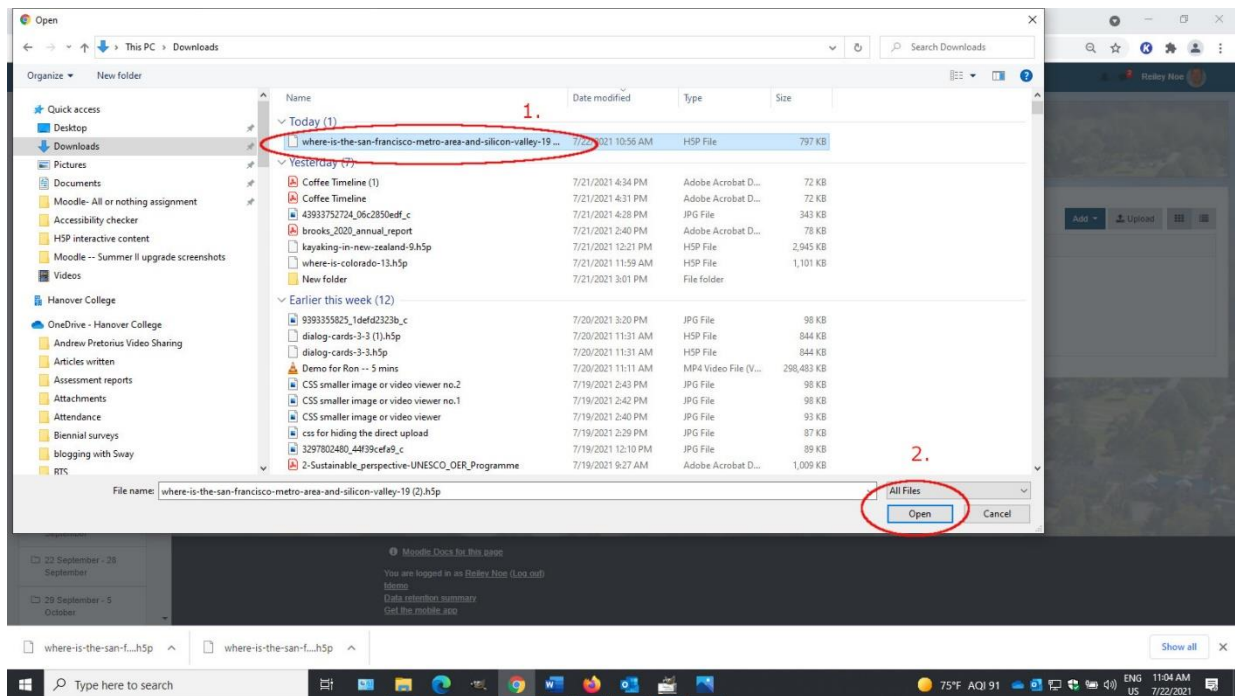
7. In the file picker, click on the **Choose File** button.



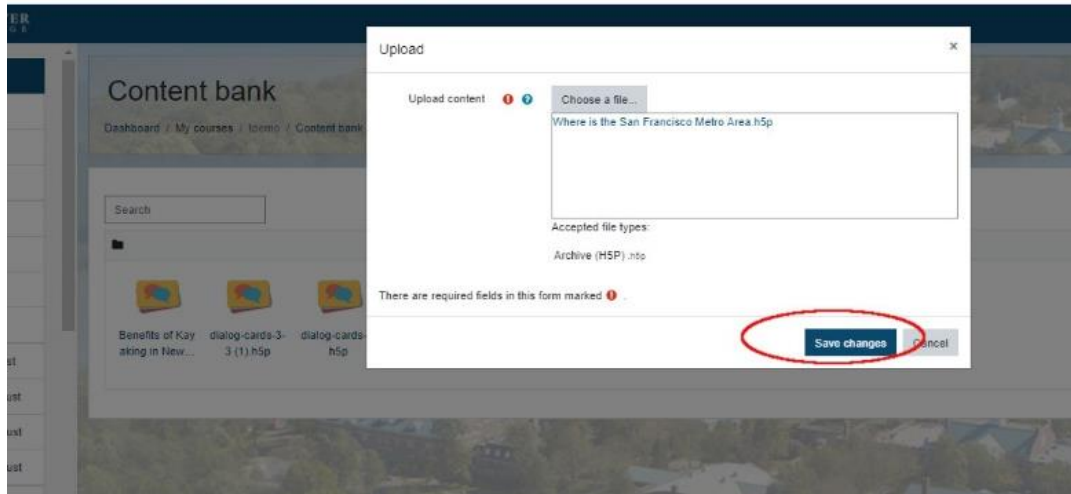
8. Scroll in your computer to the Downloads area and click on Downloads.



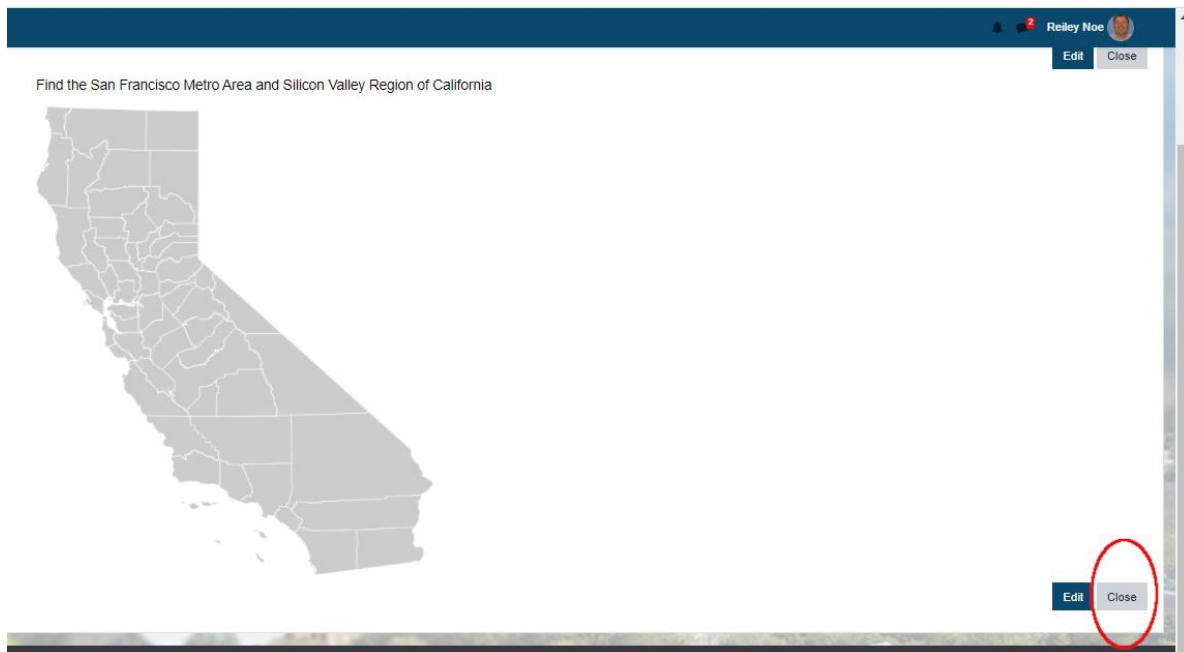
9. Click on the H5P activity that you've saved. It should appear in your downloads, probably near the top if you saved it recently. Highlight it and click on Open.



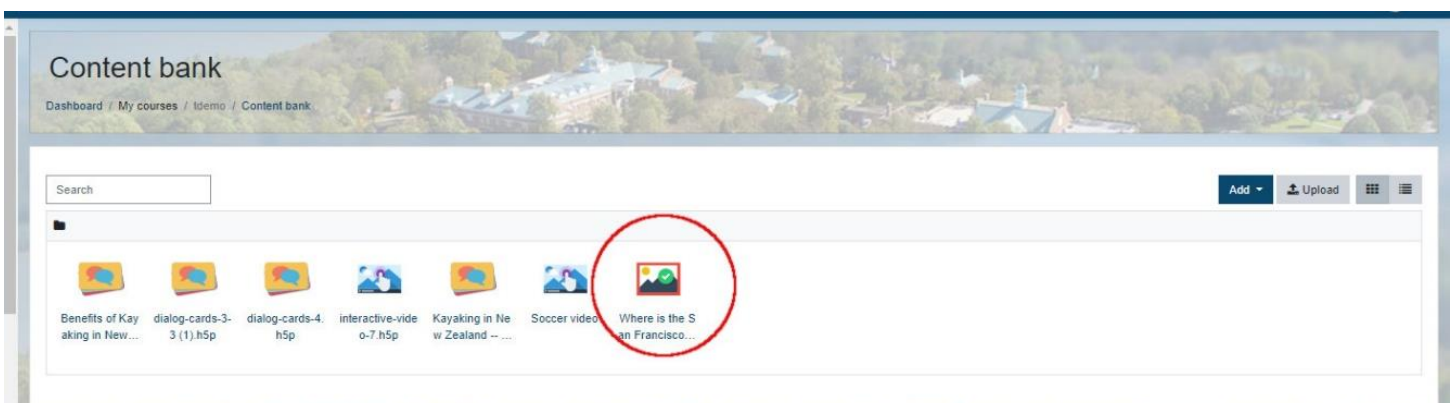
10. The title populates in the box. Click Save Changes.



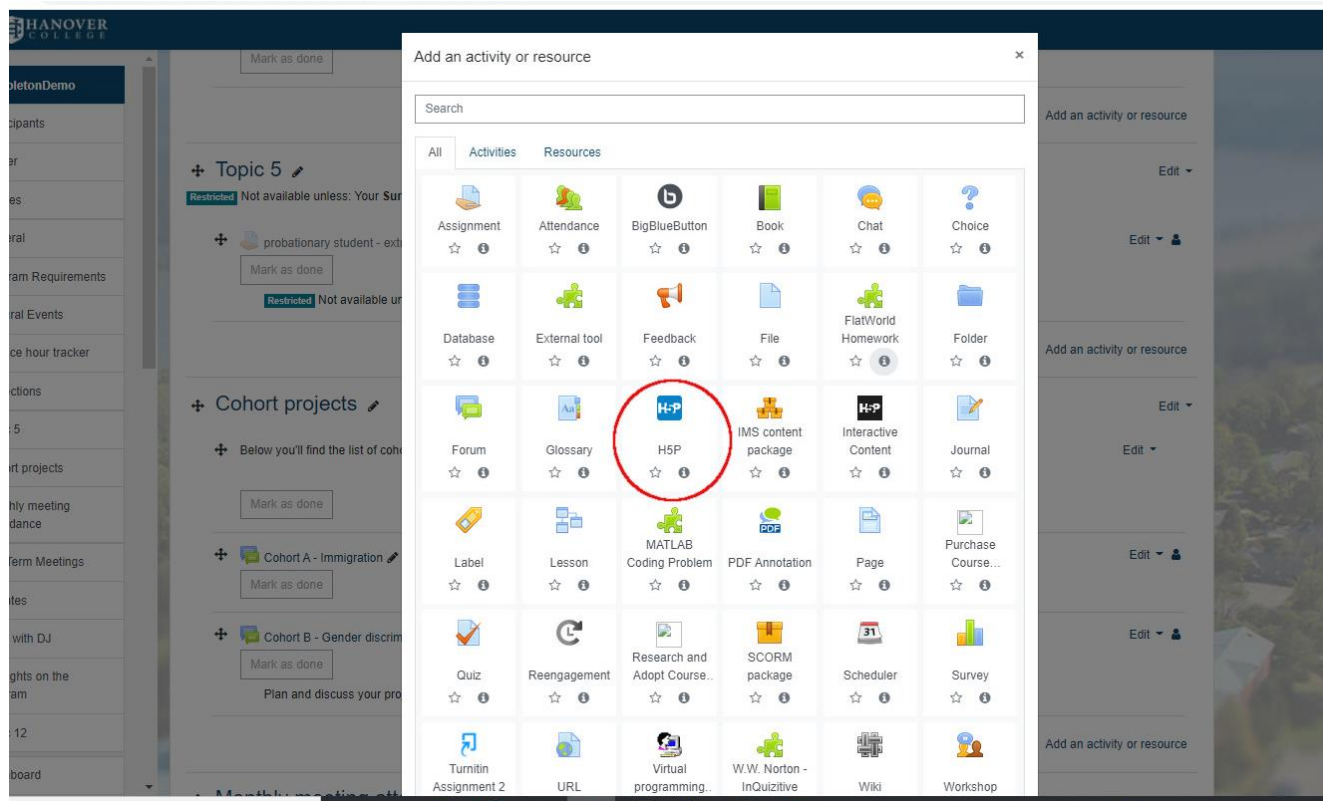
11. You'll see the actual activity. Don't be alarmed. Just click the gray **Close** button.



12. You'll see the content appear in the Content Bank for the class.



From here you can download the item into your course by clicking on **Add an Activity or Resource** and in the Activity Chooser, pick the H5P Icon.



Give it a title, description, upload it by clicking on the dog-eared page to access the file picker. Once you've selected it adjust the settings and click save. It will appear on the course page.
