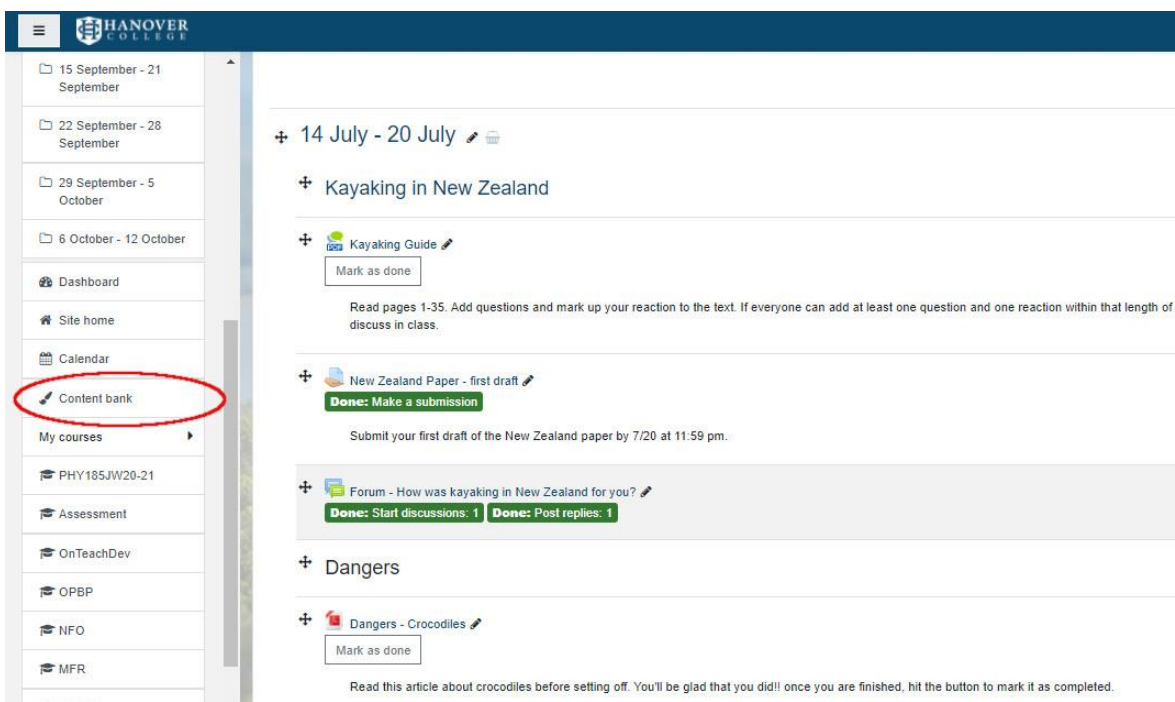


Moving H5P Activities Between Content Banks in Different Courses

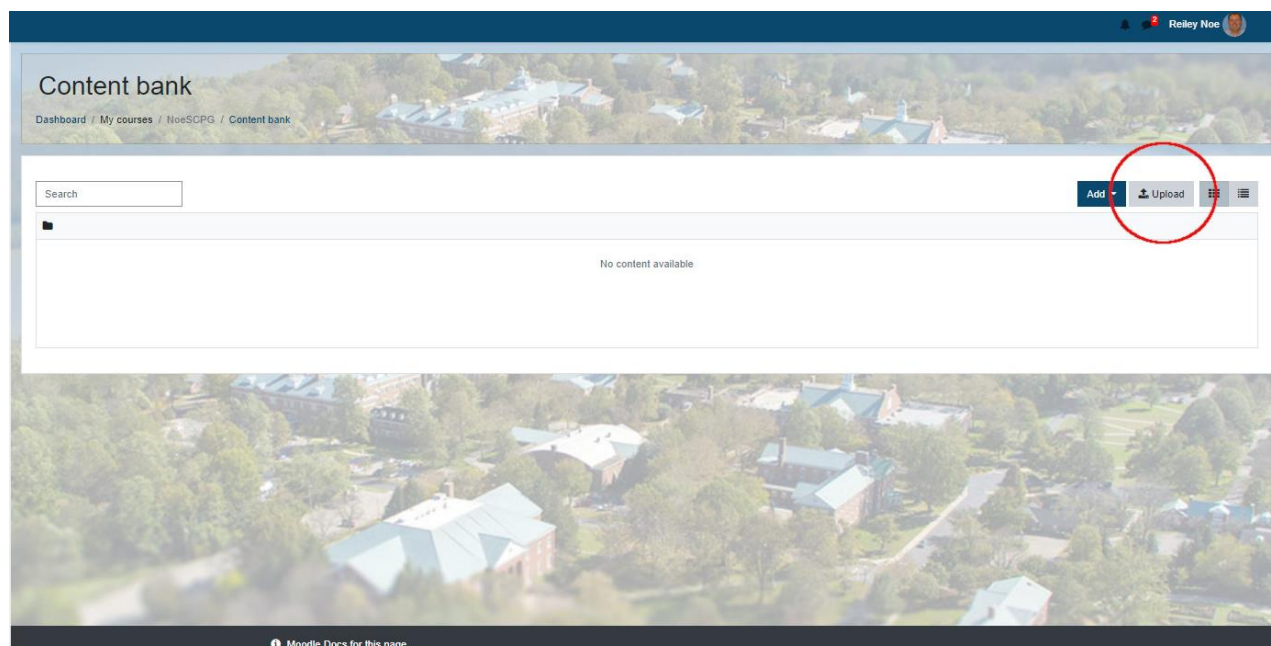
You can create and store H5P content in a content bank, but it is important to remember that the content bank is not a content bank for every class you are a teacher in. Rather, it is a content bank distinct for one specific class.

Still, you can grab H5P activities from other classes and move them into another class fairly easily. Here is how you can do this.

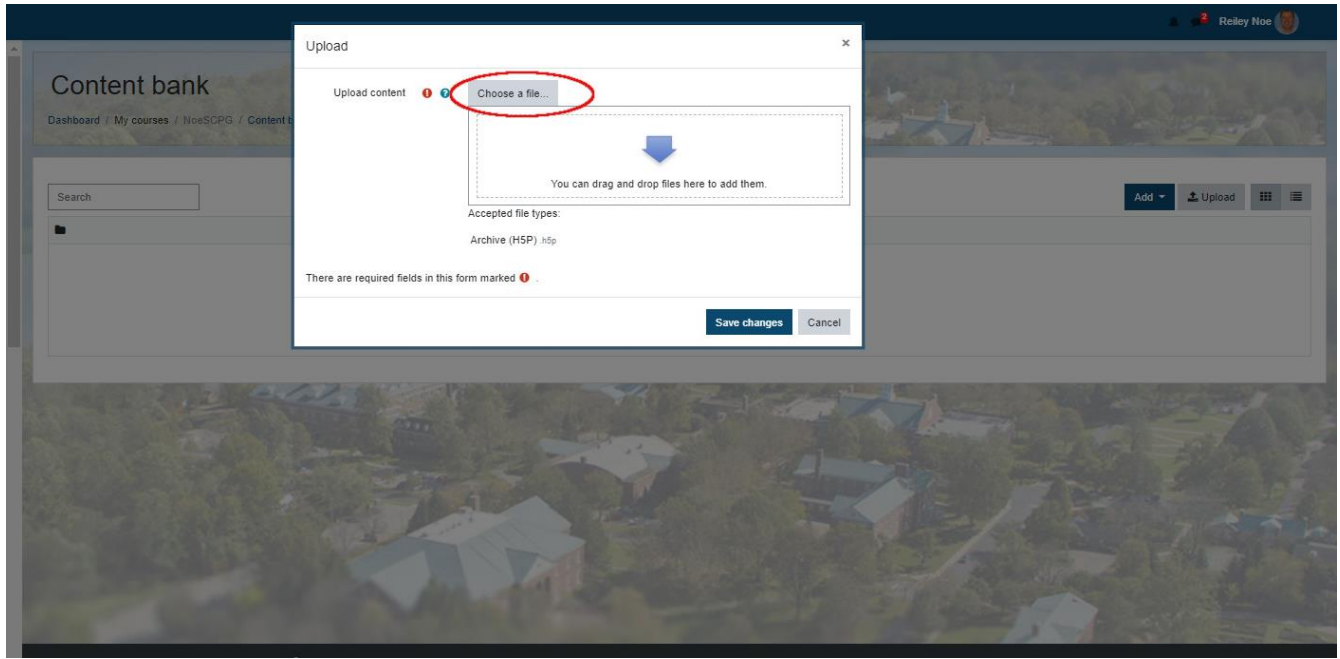
1. Click on the **Content Bank** tile, which is below the weeks or topics that you are covering in a class, but before.



2. You'll see a blank Content Bank screen like what you see below. Click **Upload**.

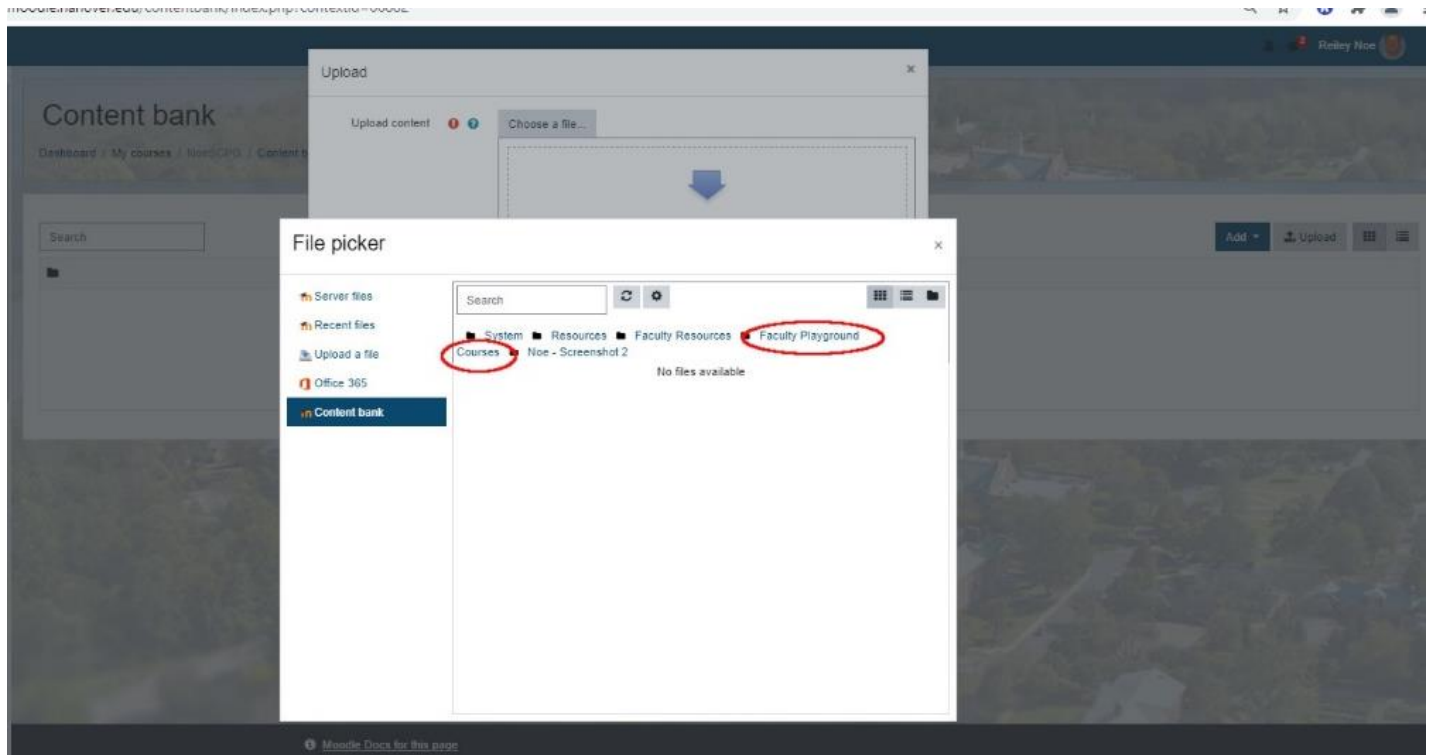


3. Click on the **Choose a File** button

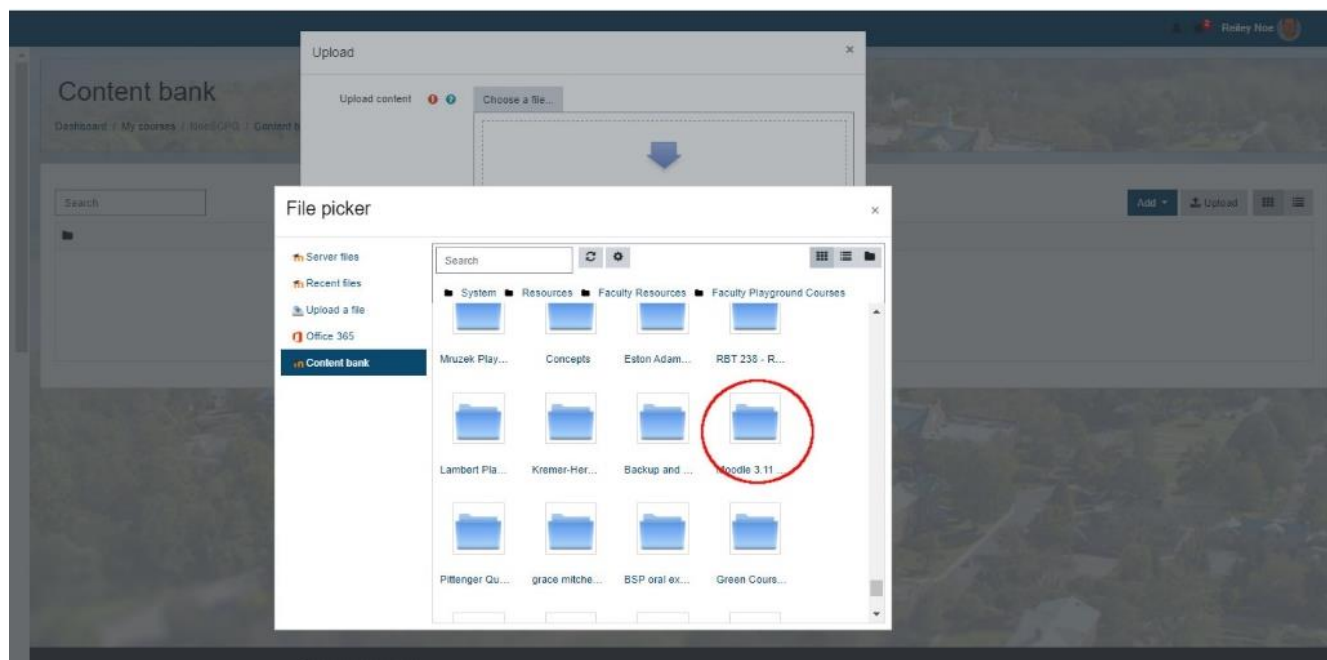


4. In the **File Picker** popup you'll see a breadcrumb trail, which is the term for those blue hyperlinks that you'll see below. They show you the hierarchy of different folders where classes are nested (both playground classes and 'real' classes by term).

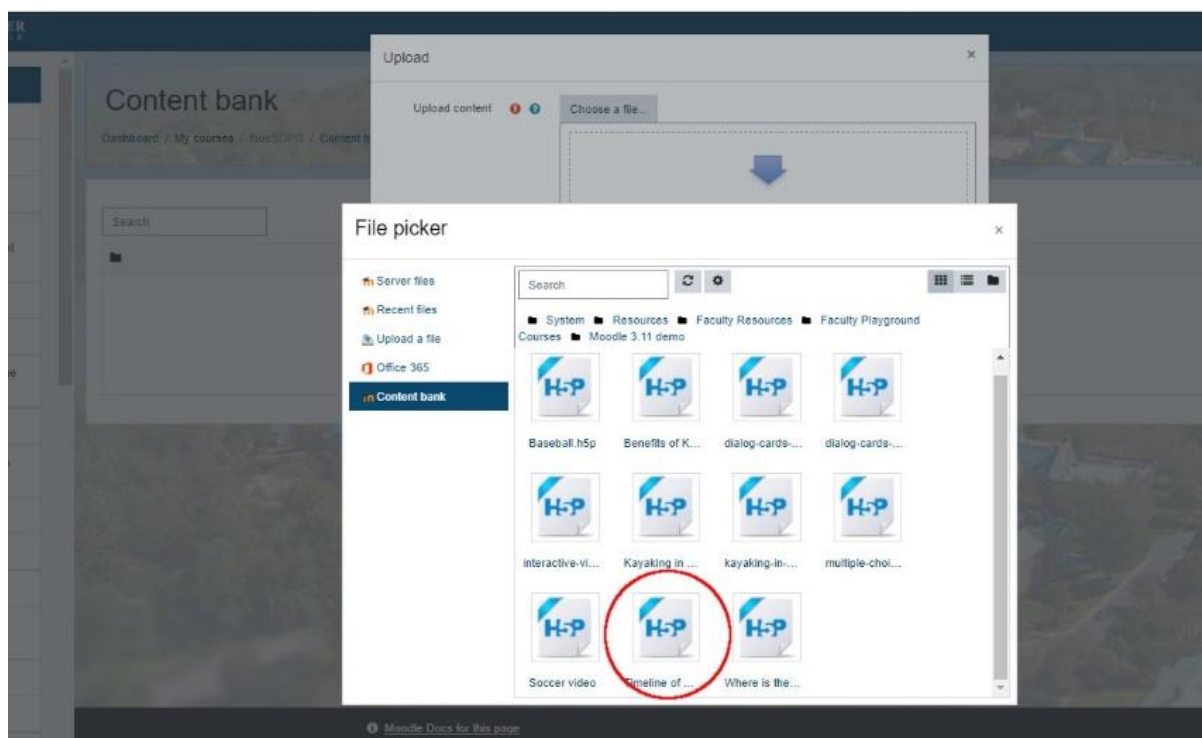
Click on one that contains the class where you will be moving content from. I'll look in **Faculty Playground Courses** here, but you might be looking at a directory that shows terms and dates of older classes.



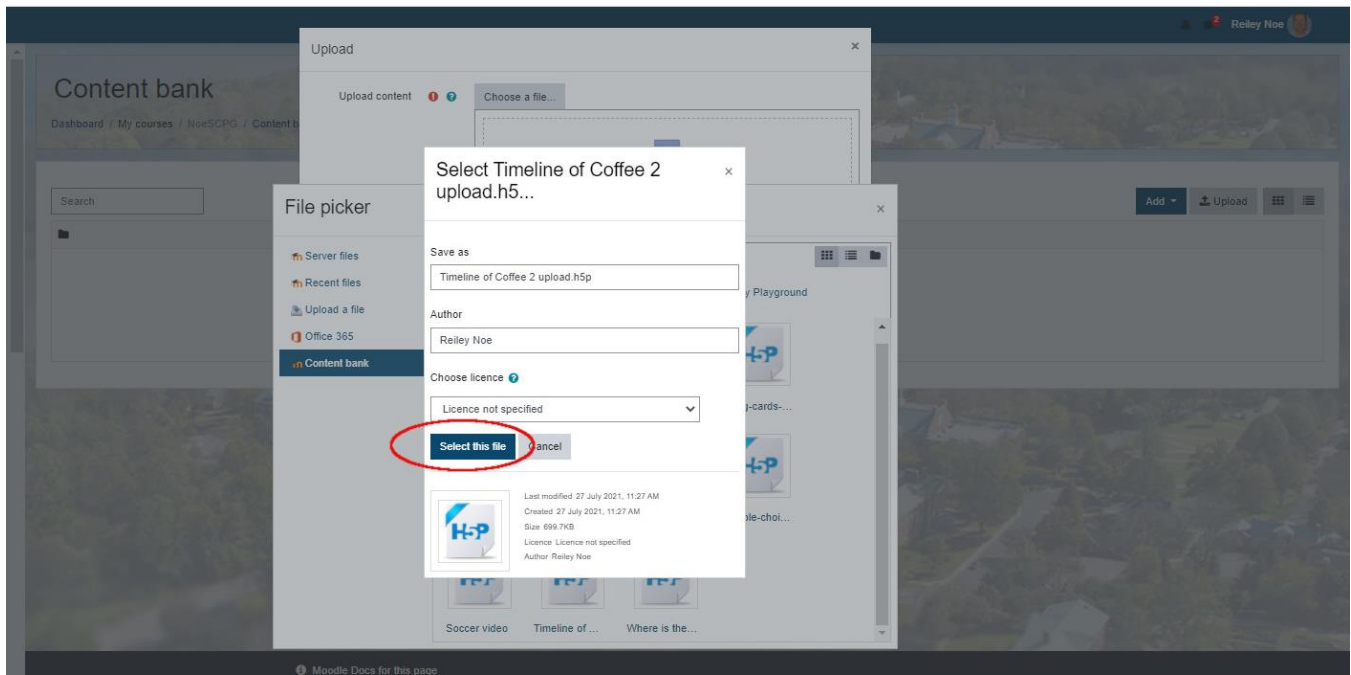
5. I've clicked on the breadcrumb trail link for the Faculty Playground Courses, and I get a set of folders with H5P content banks within them. I'm going to look at the **Moodle 3.11 demo class** because I know that the H5P timeline that I want to reuse in this class was originally set up in that class and saved to that content bank.



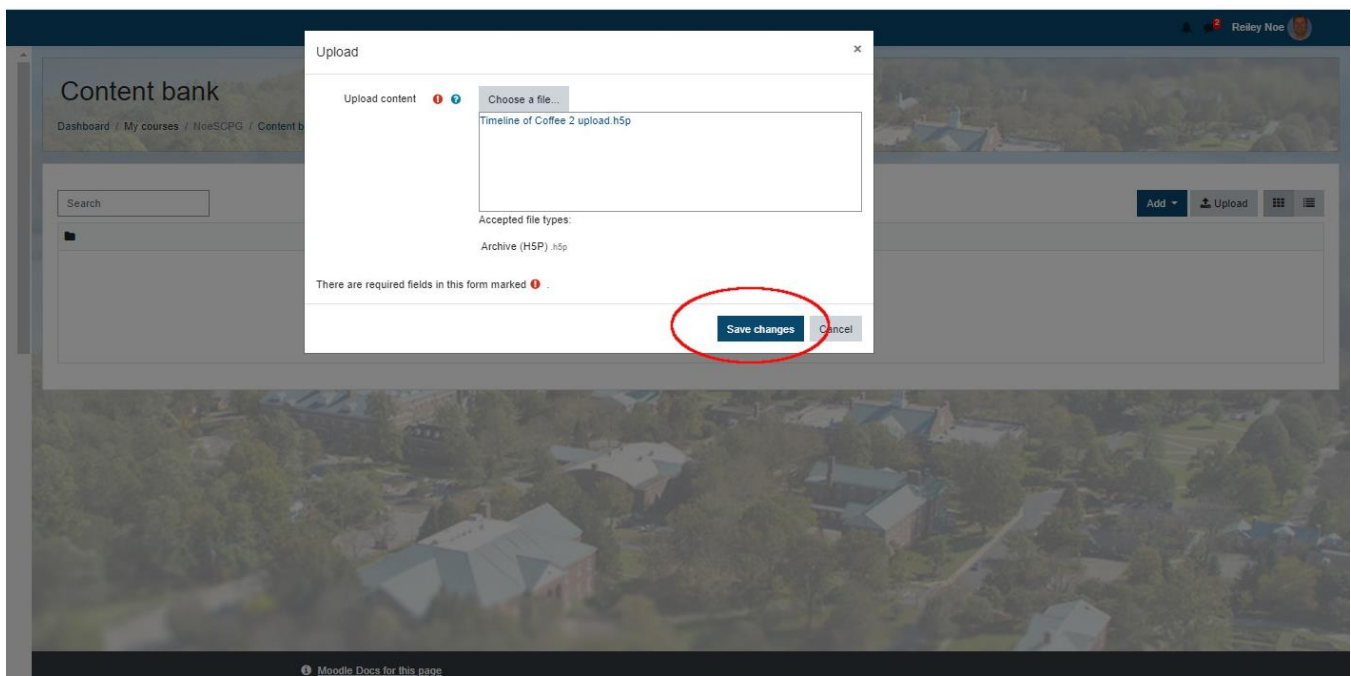
6. Once I'm inside the Moodle 3.11 Demo class, I see all of the H5P objects that have been created, and I'll click on the **Timeline of Coffee** to move that to the class that I'm currently in.



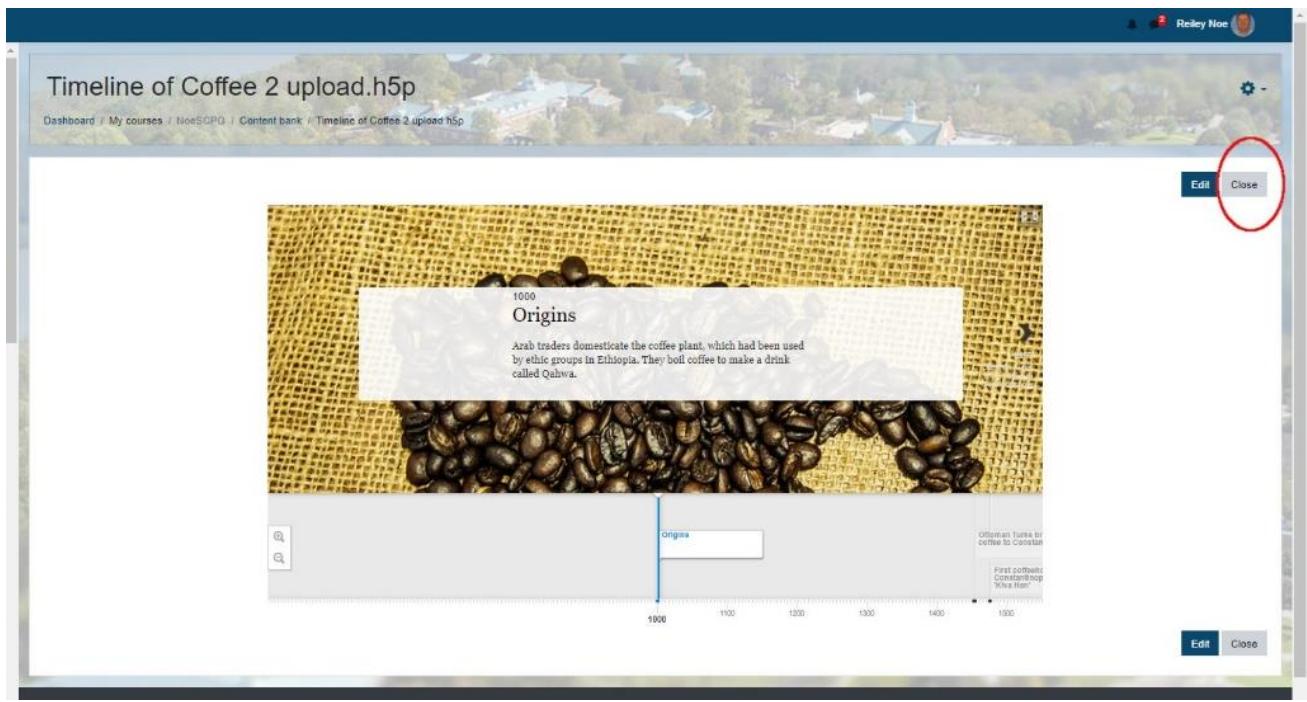
7. Click on **Select this File**.



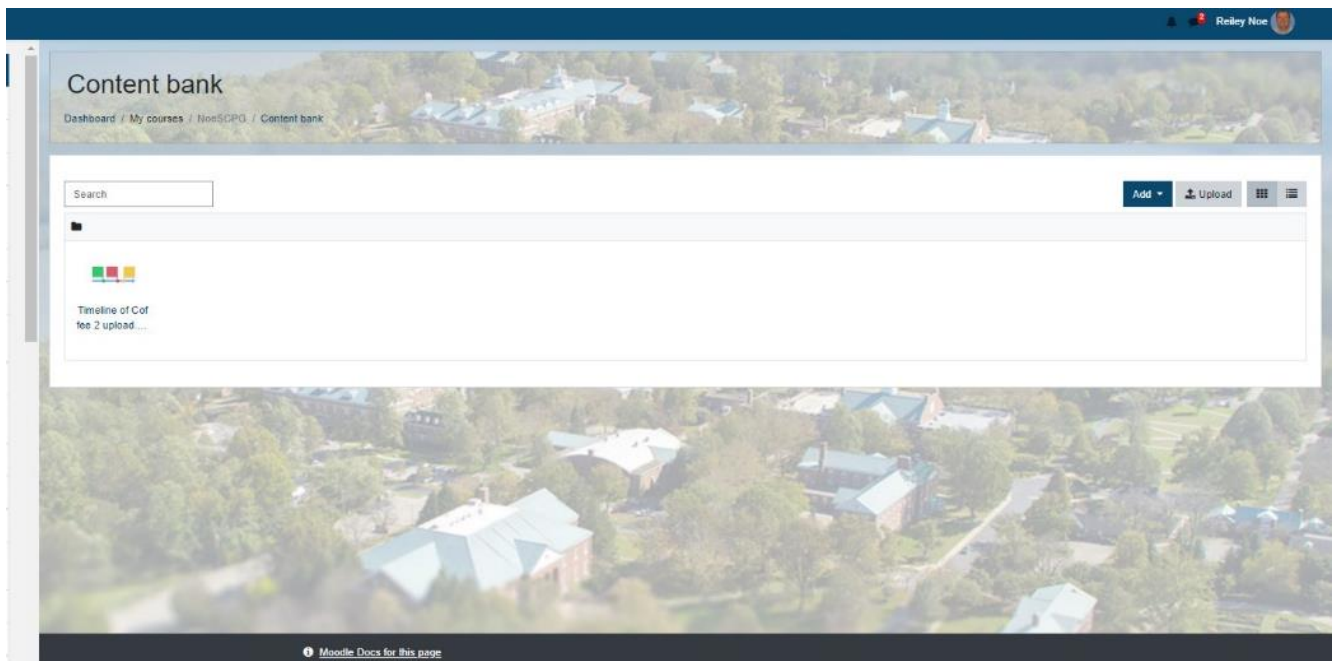
8. Click on **Save Changes**.



9. The timeline appears on the screen. You can edit it from the **Edit** button, but we'll just click **Close**.

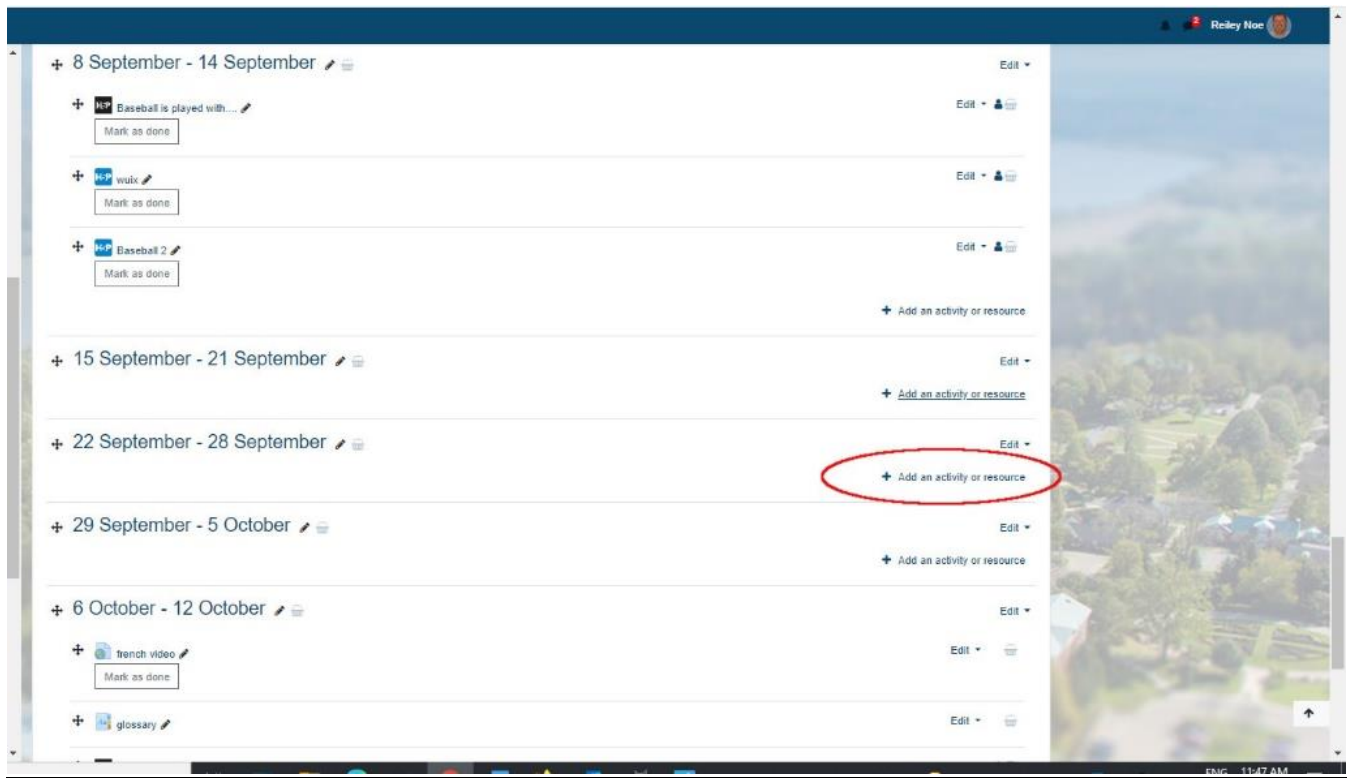


10. And the timeline appears in the content bank. From here you can add it to a page.

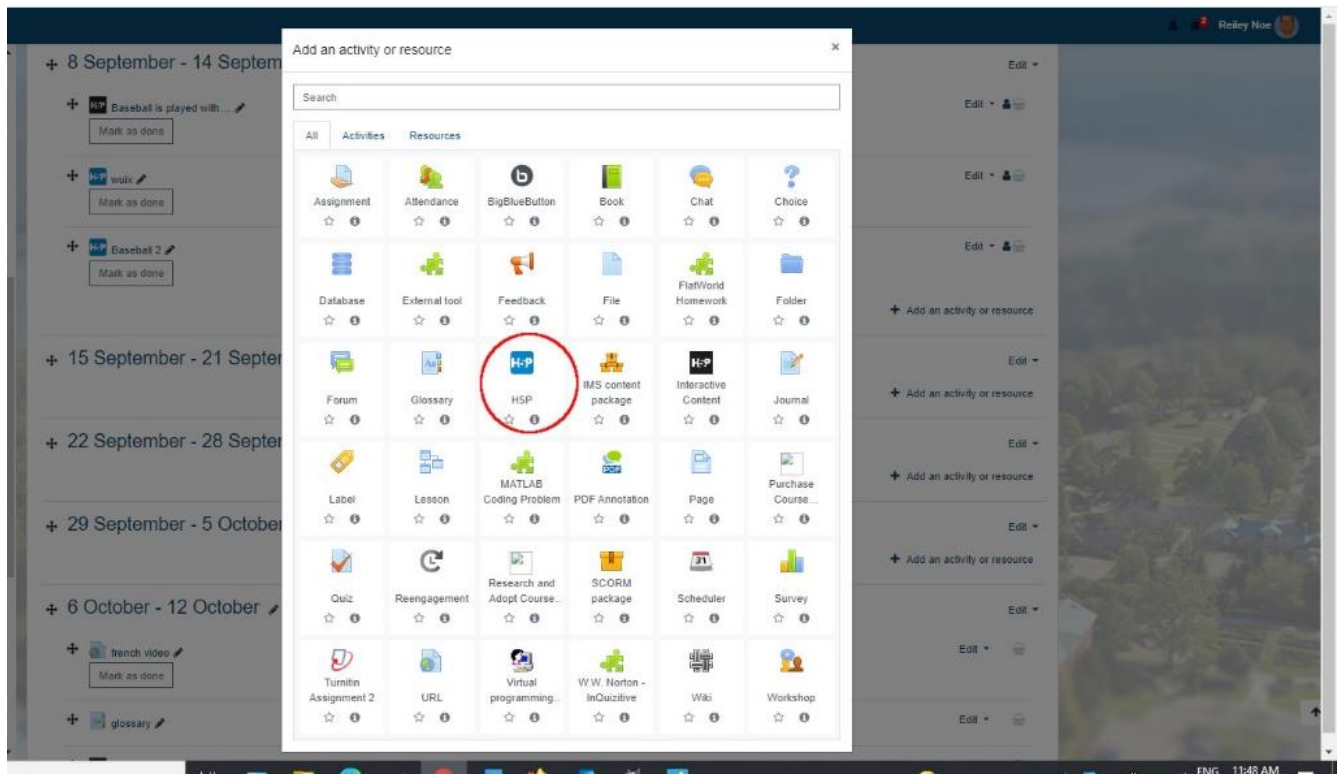


Moving the new H5P item from the content bank to the course page.

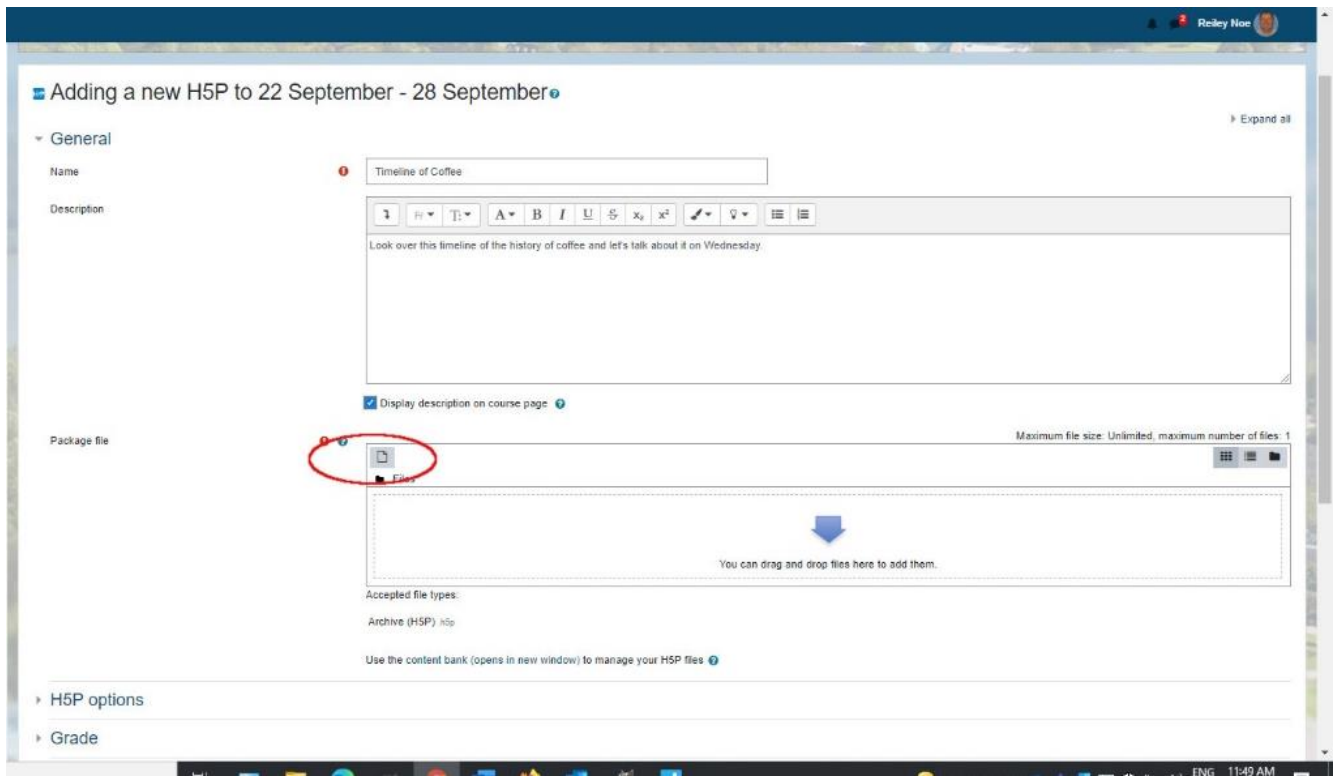
11. Click on **Add a Resource or Activity**.



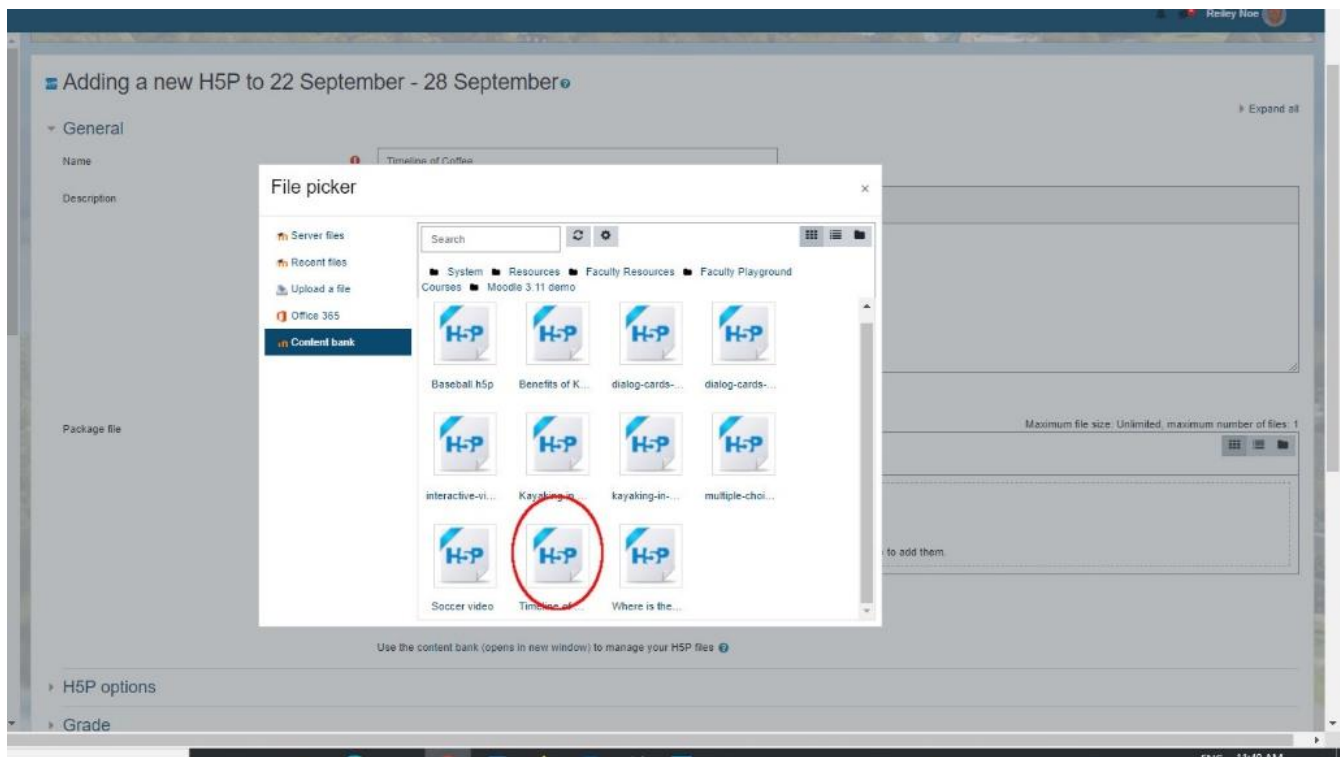
12. Pick the **H5P** icon.



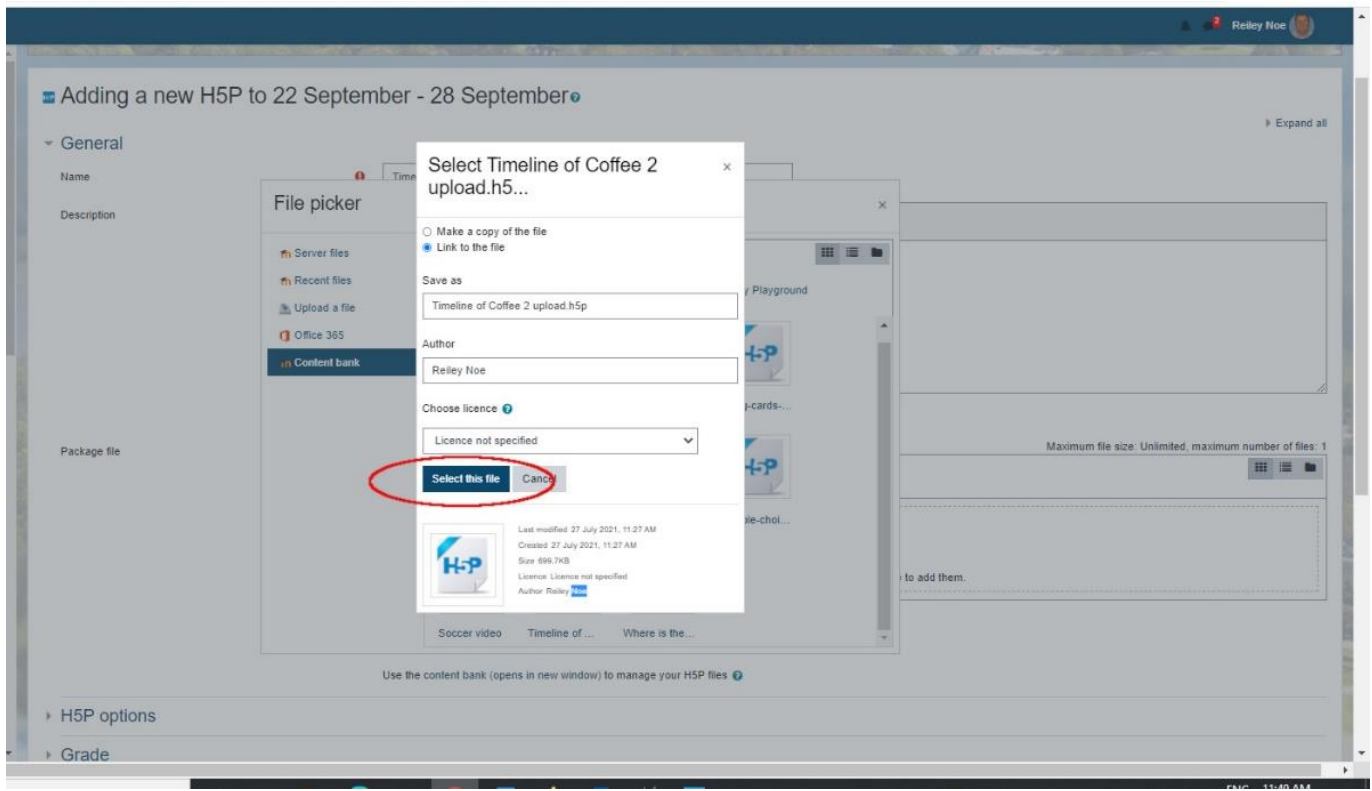
13. Click on the **dog-eared paper icon** to pick a file to upload.



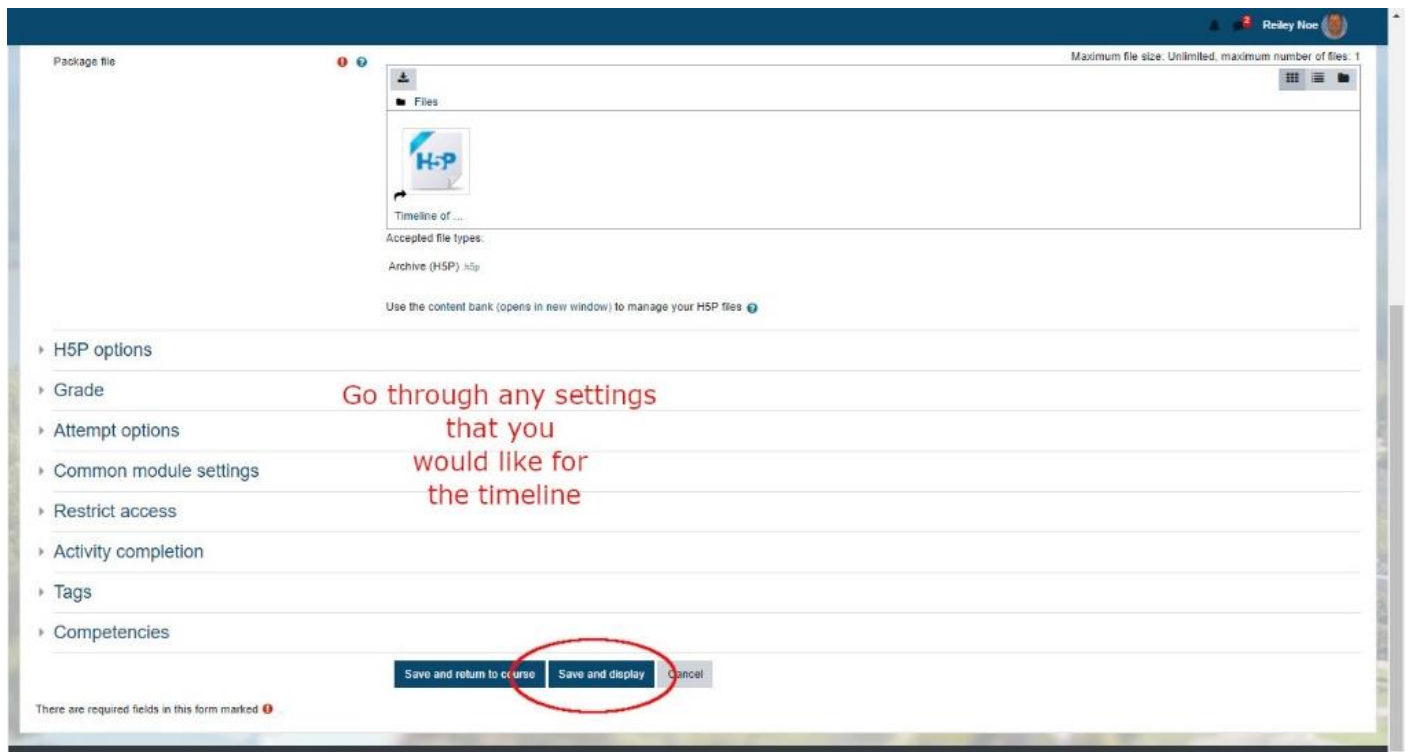
14. Select the **Timeline** icon so that we can display it on the course page.



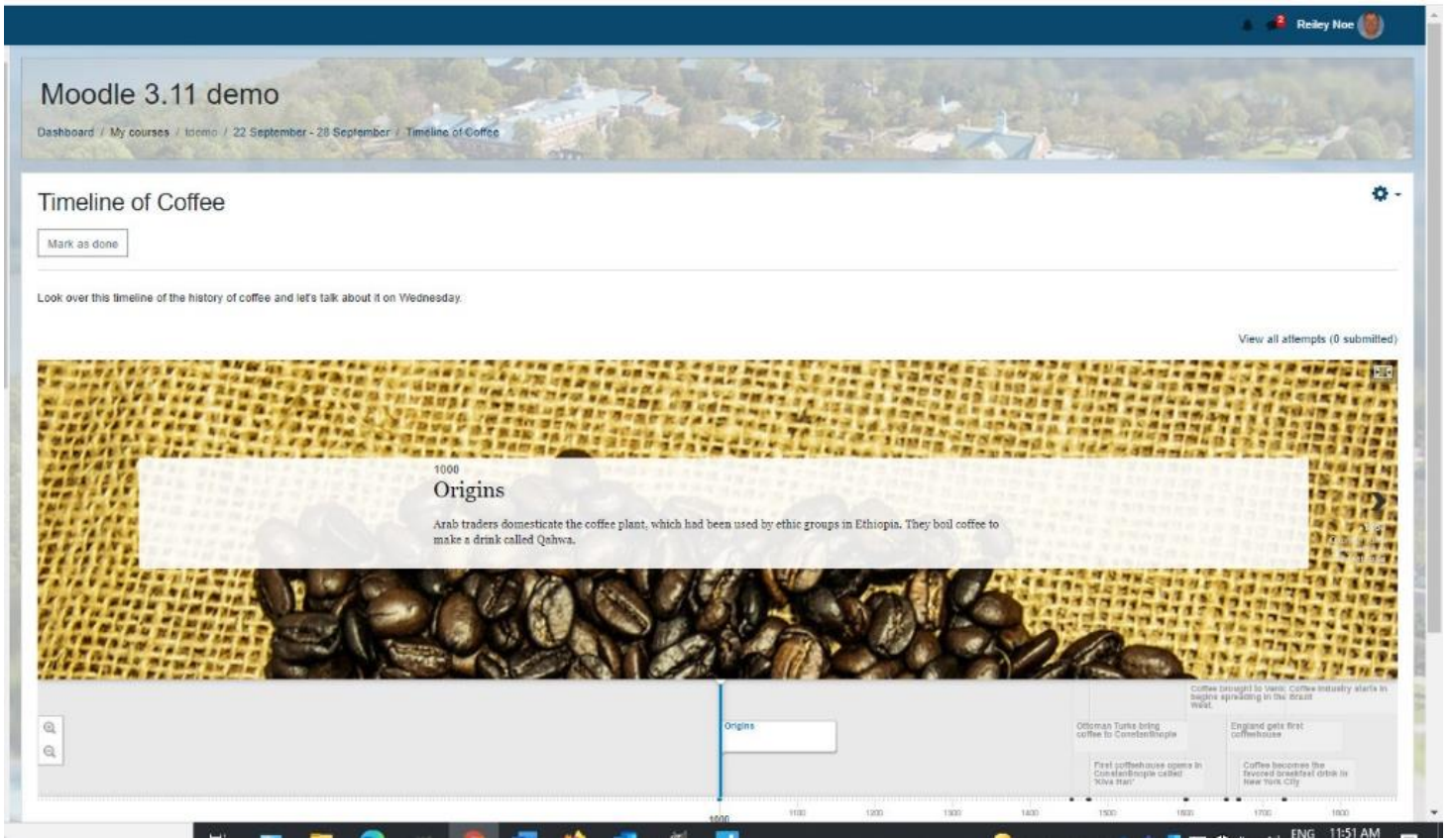
15. Click on **Select this File**.



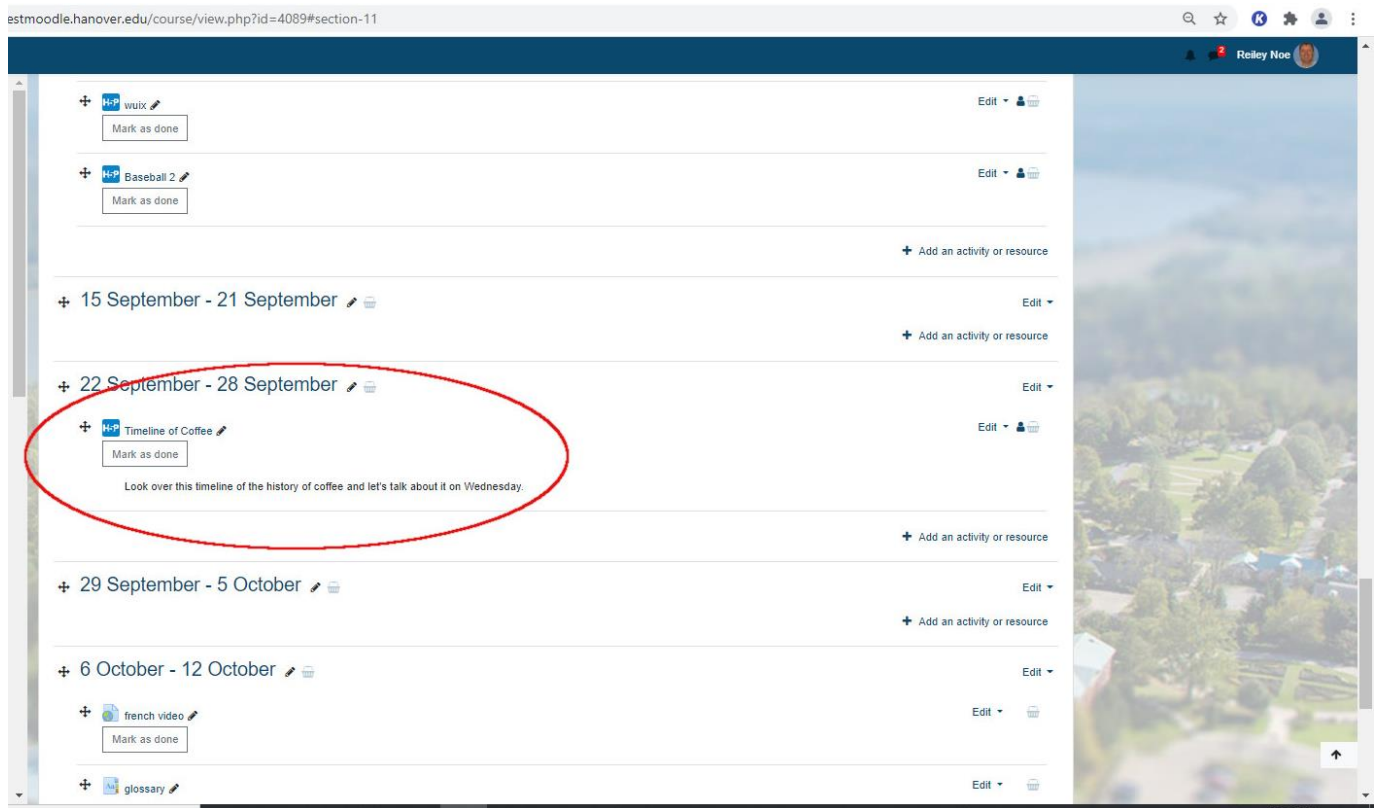
16. Look over the settings and apply those that you want. Timeline isn't a graded activity, but you can set up Activity Completion.



17. The timeline appears on the page.



18. This is what it looks like on the course page.
