

Taking non-graded H5P content out of your gradebook.

Everything that you create in H5P automatically is populated as a graded item in your gradebook, regardless of whether the activity is interactive enough to generate a grade. A timeline is a good example. Students can look over the timeline, but they do not generate a grade in using it.


1. We'll look at this timeline as an example.



2. This is what it looks like on a course page. Students would click on the link or the icon to access the timeline.




3. And so, even though it is not a gradeable item, it will appear in the course grade, which can be confusing for students. Here is how to eliminate this confusion.




Removing the nongraded Item from the Gradebook.


4. Go to the course page. Click on the **Edit** link across from the item and **Edit settings**.




5. On the Settings page, scroll down.



6. In the Grade area, change the grade type from Point to None.



7. Although the timeline is still on the course page – you haven't deleted it - it is no longer in the gradebook. This saves space in the grade book and prevents confusion among students.
