

What is new in Moodle 3.11?

Over the summer, we upgraded to Moodle 3.11. Here are some of the new features.

Activity Completion / Completion Tracking

The Activity Completion marking has been improved in ways that will greatly help you keep track of what you've done and what you need to do. In the past this was done with tick boxes. Now it is much more visible and, if it is configured so, it can let you know what you need to do

Please note that using this feature is at the discretion of you professor. Some will set this up, while others may not. If they do enable this feature, Depending on how your instructor has set it up, you may have explicit information on what you need to do to complete the activity, or will just have to mark a box as done when you've completed it. .

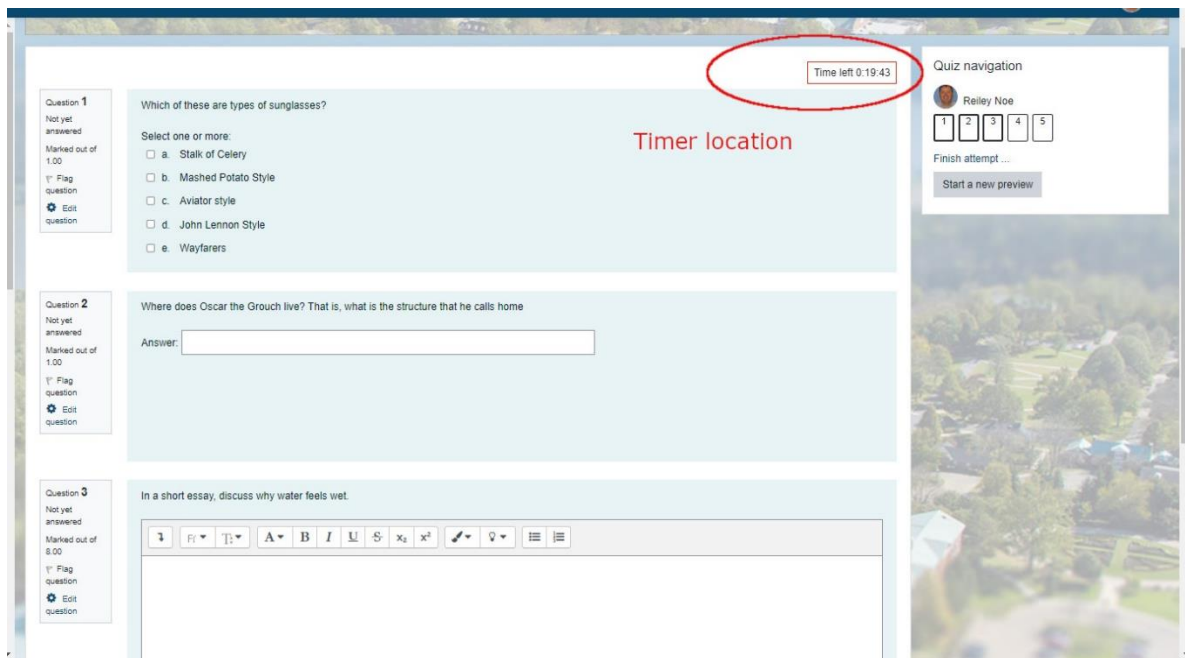
What a student sees after he or she submits their work

This is what it looks like on the course page after you've submitted the assignment or fulfilled the criteria that your prof has noted for the activity.

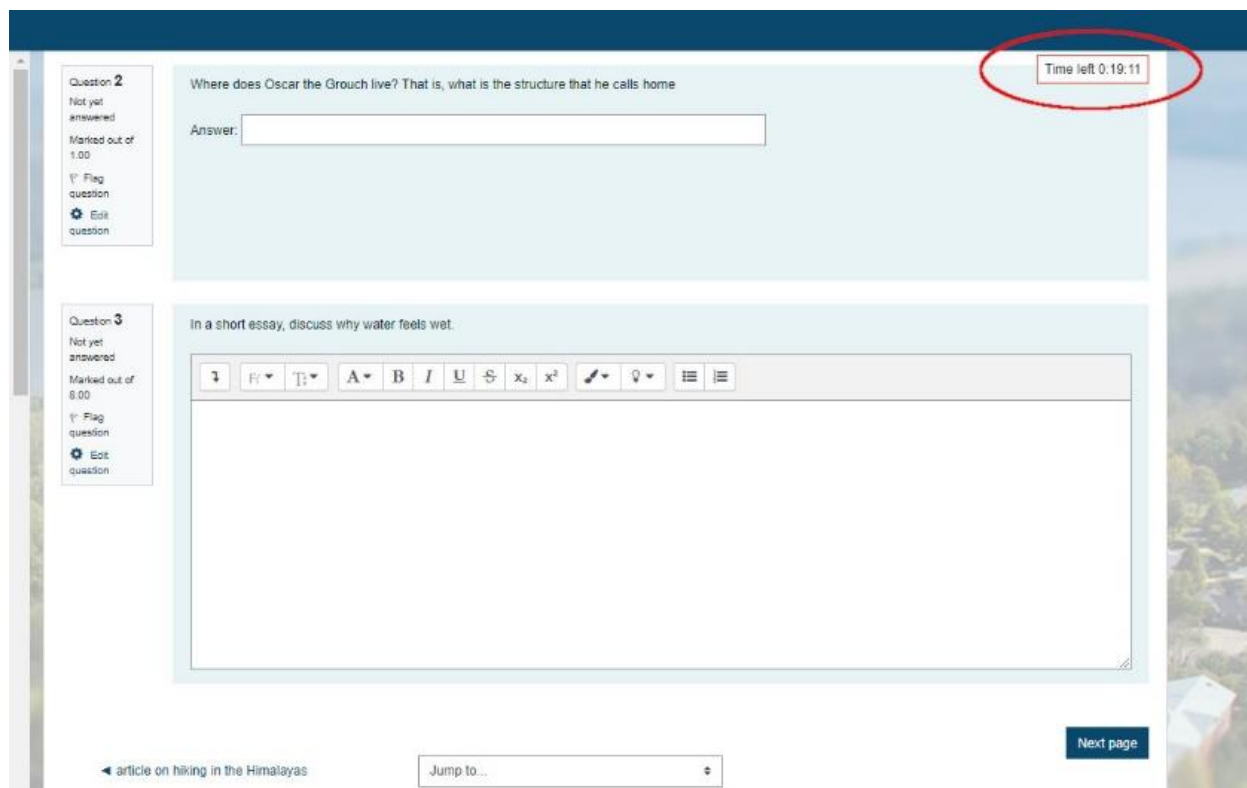

Quiz Timer

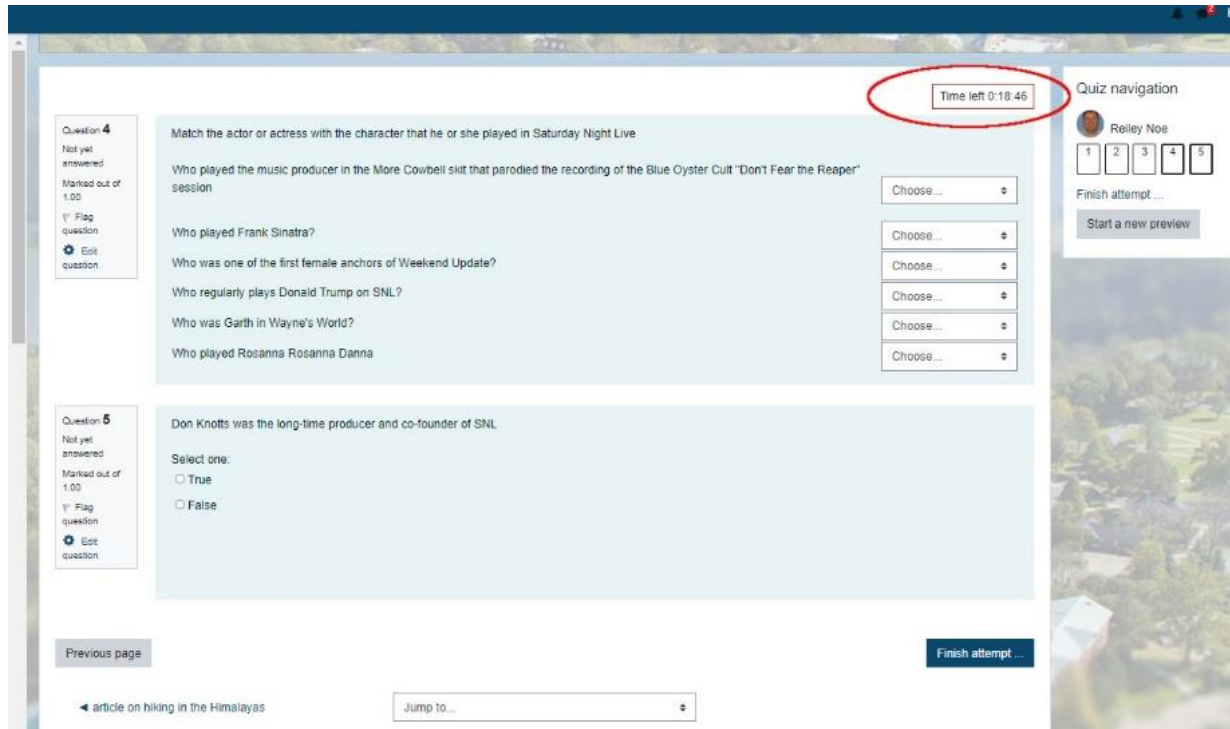
Another useful improvement is the quiz timer stays visible in quizzes even with long pages and multiple pages.



Scroll down and the timer still appears at the top.

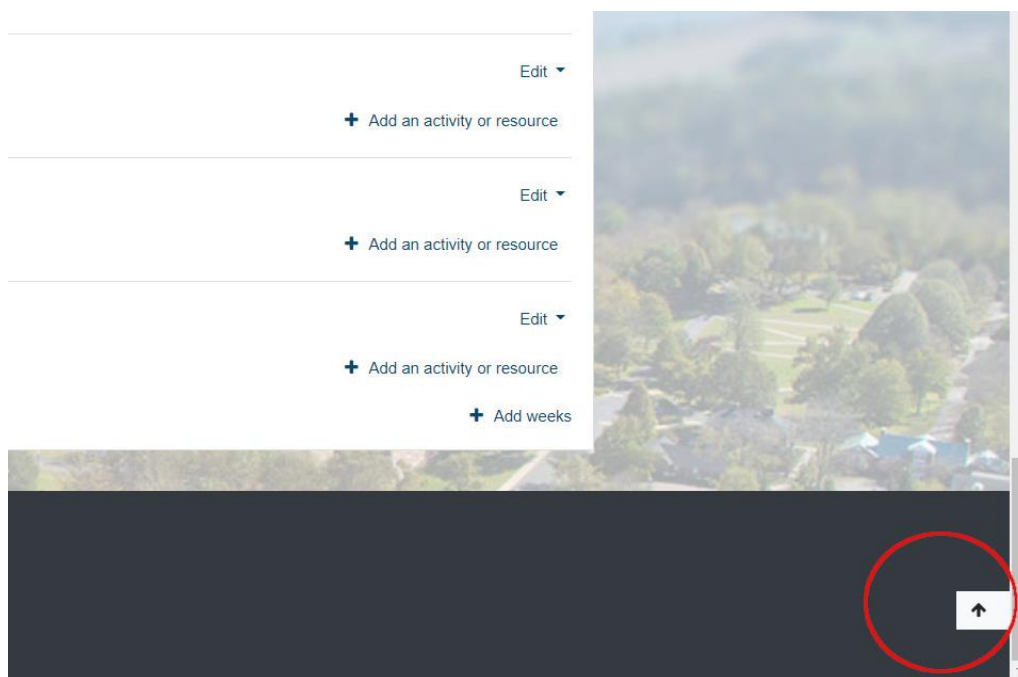


Even if you move to another page, the timer stays in place.
