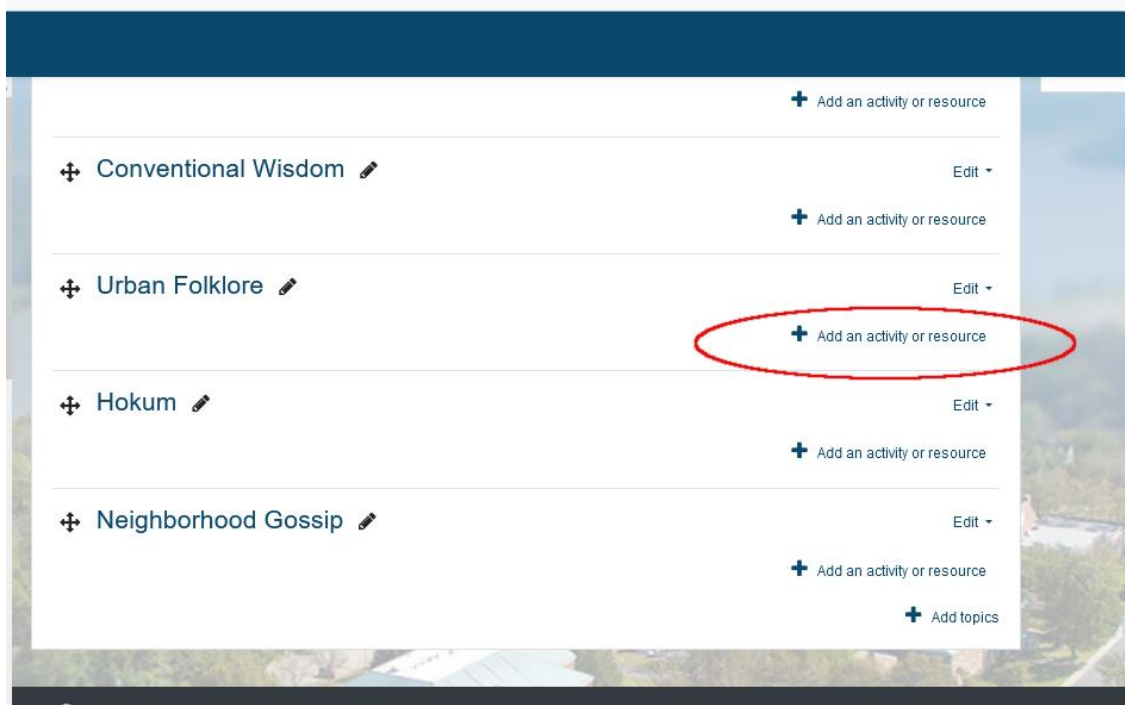


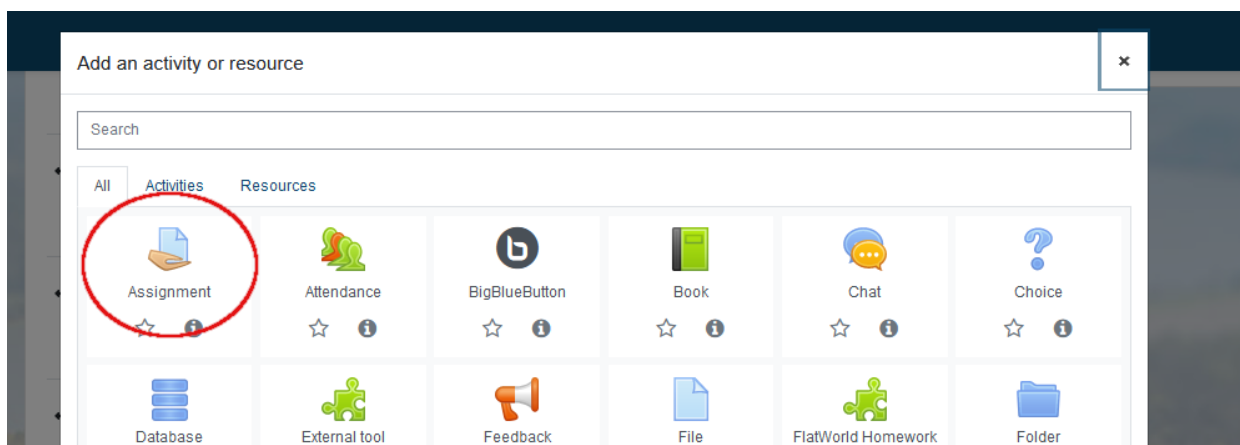
Creating Pass / Fail Assignments

You can easily create assignments that are graded as pass / fail rather than as a percentage.

1. Create an assignment as you normally do. Click on Add an Activity or Resource.



2. Click on Assignment.



3. Name it and scroll down to fill out the rest of the settings germane to what you want to do in the assignment.

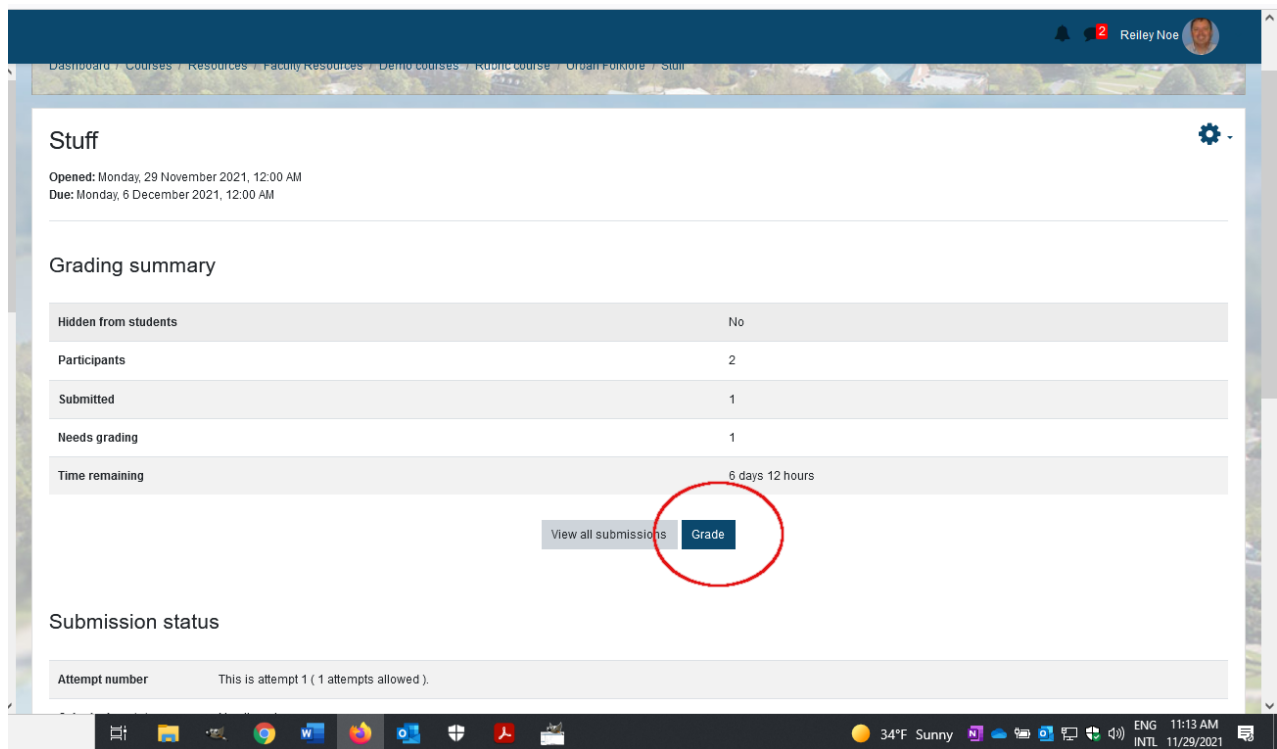

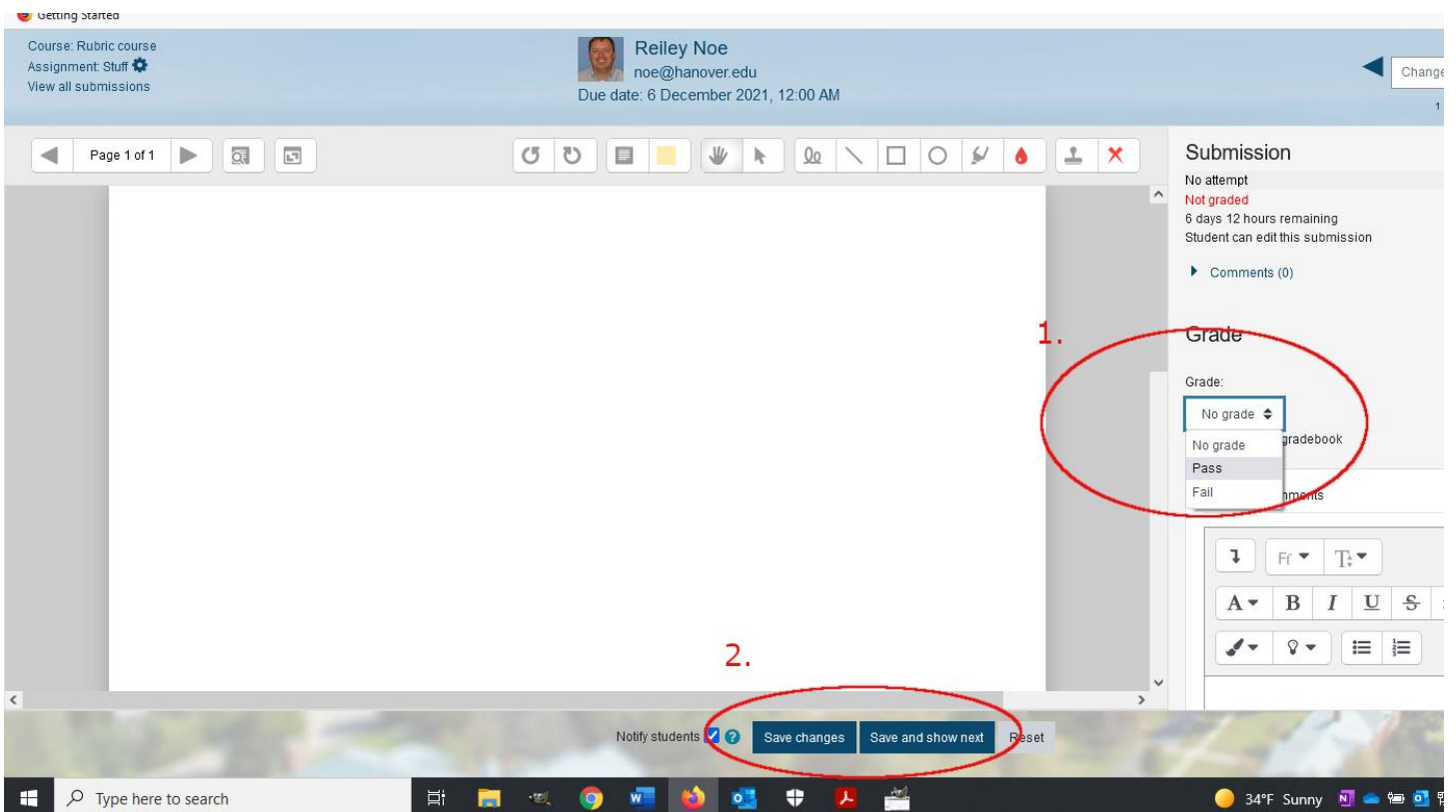
