



Restricting an activity to a particular student and a particular time.

If you have a student that will access an activity before or after the rest of the students, you can restrict access to the student for a particular time and hide it on the course page so that he or she cannot access it until a particular time, or he or she can view it at a particular time before other students.


1. Click on the Restrict Access at the bottom of the activity settings. Then click on the Add Restriction button.




2. You can restrict with any button on this list. We'll use the User Profile here to restrict a student by name.



3. After you've added the name or names that you are restricting, then click on Add Restriction



4. Click on Date.



5. Add the date. You can hide or show a date from a particular date or until a particular date. In this case you'll want to hide it until a date for the student that takes is later.


