
Creating a video in a forum


You can post a video directly in a forum. You will record it directly within the forum – **you won't be recording it and uploading it**. If you are a Mac user, use either the Chrome or the Firefox browser. Safari will not work well with this.

If you are the first person to post, here's what you do:


1. Click on the blue button to post, then add a name for your post. Click the down arrow to reveal a new line in the text editor. The camera icon will allow you to record video.




2. Click on the bar to record. It will turn red when you hover over it.




3. When you are finished, click the red bar to stop the recording.




4. Click on the white button to record again or the blue button to submit the recording.




5. Click on the blue post to forum button to add this to the forum.




6. This is what it looks like after the initial post.




7. You can reply with text or with a video. To reply, just click on the link to the original post.




8. Click on reply




9. Click on Advanced to generate the text box that you will use to record your video.




10. Name your reply, if necessary. Click on the down arrow to reveal another line of icons in the text box. Click on the camera for record your video.




11. Hover over the bar and click it to record.



12. Click on the bar to re-record or on the blue bar to attach their recording.



13. Click on the Post to Forum to add your video reply.
