



# How to allow for video submissions in Moodle Forums

Students can submit video posts and replies in Moodle forums. Here is how to set it up.


1. Go to the Gear. Turn on Editing. Click on the Add a Resource or Activity link in a week that you would like the forum to take place and then pick the forum from the menu.




2. Add a name for the forum and a description


- Click on the blue button to post, then add a name for your post. Click the down arrow to reveal a new line in the text editor. The camera icon will allow you to record video.




- Click on the bar to record. It will turn red when you hover over it.




5. When you are finished, click the red bar to stop the recording.




6. Click on the red button to record again or the blue button to submit the recording.



7. Click on the blue post to forum button to add this to the forum.

9. To reply with a video, just click on the link to the original post.






11. Click on Advanced to generate the text box that you will use to record your video.




12. Name your reply, if necessary. Click on the down arrow to reveal another line of icons in the text box. Click on the camera for record your video.




13. Hover over the bar and click it to record.




14. Click on the bar to re-record or on the blue bar to attach their recording.
