

## Moving a grade item.

There are times when you'll want to re-arrange grade items into different categories and within different categories. It is not difficult, but it isn't very easy to discern how to do this. This is the process.


1. Click the tick box across from the particular grade items that you want to move into a different category. We want to move the two forums and the two essays into the proper grade category so that the gradebook aggregates their grade automatically.




2. You'll see something like this. We're going to tick on Forum A and B.




3. Now scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on the double arrows on the Choose menu next to Move Selected Items to.




4. Select the Category that you would like the grade items to move into. Here we're



5. The two forums move into the Forum category. To move the essays, we'll tick the boxes next to the two essays.




6. Select the Essay category from the drop-down menu.




7. Notice that everything is in its proper category. So that's good.

But notice that the sequencing is wrong – Essay B is on top of Essay A, and you'll see the same situation in the Forum category.

There is one more thing to do....




8. To rearrange the order within a category – like to move Forum 2 beneath Forum 1 – you'll want to click on the double arrow icon to the left of the item that you want to move.



9. You'll see some bars appear above and beneath grade items and grading categories.

Pick out the logical place for it to appear and click on the bar directly beneath it. Since we want Essay B to be after Essay A, just click on that box and it will appear there.



10. And Essay B sorts itself to being just beneath Essay A. Here, you'll want to do the same thing for Forum A and Forum B, too.
