Quizzes in Moodle

You can use Moodle's Quiz activity to create online tests and quizzes. In some cases, you can have the objective questions be automatically graded and sent to your gradebook – which can be a massive time saver.

A Moodle quiz might look like this:

You can enhance security of online exams with either the Lockdown Browser or Respondus Monitor.

Lockdown Browser will prevent students from accessing their hard drive or opening up windows other windows during an exam. Respondus Monitor does this and it also takes control of the webcam of a student taking an exam. You can use this to have the student show the room on camera before the exam as well as monitor their behavior during the exam.
